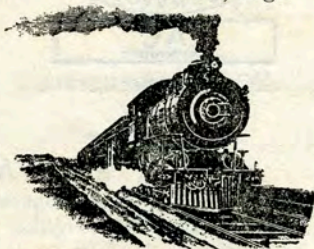

WATSONVILLE

In the Valley of the Apple

Pajaro Valley, Santa Cruz County, California



When Nature distributed her gifts, the region in which Watsonville is located surely received its full share. Situated as it is on the curving rim of Monterey Bay, almost completely surrounded by picturesque mountains and hills, the center of a fertile valley traversed from end to end by the Pajaro River, enjoying an equable climate, and with such scenic wonders as the Big Trees of Santa Cruz and the rugged coast line of Monterey Bay within easy access, it is not surprising that Watsonville enjoys a high degree of solid, substantial prosperity. The City of Watsonville has a population of about 9,000; it is the trading and financial center for a thickly settled agricultural district of about 25,000 people, and has shown a steady growth in population characteristic of the steady advancement of the community.

Watsonville is 100 miles from San Francisco; being one of the principal division points of the Southern Pacific Company Coast Lines, where several hundred railroad men are employed and reside, enjoying the substantial income of an enormous payroll which is distributed twice a month. The main Transcontinental line of the Southern Pacific Company traverses the Valley from north to south, and the Santa Cruz Branch Line crosses it from east to west; being one of the hundreds of wonderful spots in the State of California as seen by rail while traveling over the Southern Pacific Lines and enjoyed yearly by thousands of tourists.

The climate of Watsonville is like that of California generally, moderate throughout the year. It is the land of flowers.

Thousands of acres in the Pajaro Valley are planted in apples, namely: Newtown Pippins and Yellow Bellflowers, and nowhere else in the world is the yield per acre so heavy. The poultry and dairy industry stands next in importance. Watsonville is the shipping center for the apple industry and ships thousands of carloads of apples and their by-products to 35 states, to Canada, Mexico and even to England,

Norway, Hawaii and the Orient. The industry supports in the City of Watsonville over 100 packing houses, over 25 dryers, 2 canneries, 3 vinegar and cider works, one being the largest of its kind in the world. More than 2,500 workers are necessary to handle the output. Among the fruits and berries that thrive in this vicinity are apricots, pears, cherries, prunes, strawberries, blackberries and loganberries. Aside from fruit and berries important crops are celery, lettuce (lettuce and junk gardening are second to the apple industry in importance), sugar beets, potatoes, hay, alfalfa and sweet peas, to the culture of which large areas are devoted. The shipping industry relies almost entirely upon the splendid service and equipment of the Southern Pacific Company.

Watsonville is a city of churches. All the leading denominations are represented with large memberships and attractive edifices. The schools are second to none in the state. Besides the public schools two very fine private schools are maintained—the Moreland Notre Dame Academy and the St. Francis School for Boys, both under the direction of the Catholic Church. Practically every national fraternal organization is also represented.

The Pajaro Valley National Bank is the largest bank in Watsonville.

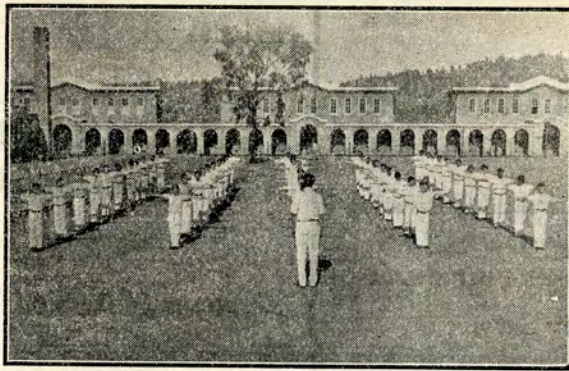
