

TIME. From 12:01 midnight to 12:00 noon (A.M. time) is shown in light faced figures, time from 12:01 noon to 12:00 midnight (P. M. time) is shown in dark faced figures.

CHILDREN under 5 years of age free, when accompanied by parent or guardian, 5 years of age and under 12, one-half fare; 12 years of age or over, full fare.

LIMIT OF TICKETS. Tickets must be used within limits printed thereon.

REDEMPTION OF TICKETS. Tickets redeemed under tariff regulations.

BAGGAGE MAXIMUMS. No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds in weight, or 72 inches in greatest dimension, or single shipment exceeding \$2,500.00 in value will be checked. Free allowance subject to tariff stipulations.

BAGGAGE from San Francisco will be checked at the Sansome and Sacramento Sts. terminal and baggage checked to San Francisco, will be delivered at this terminal.

LIABILITY LIMITED. Excess value to be declared and paid for when checking
