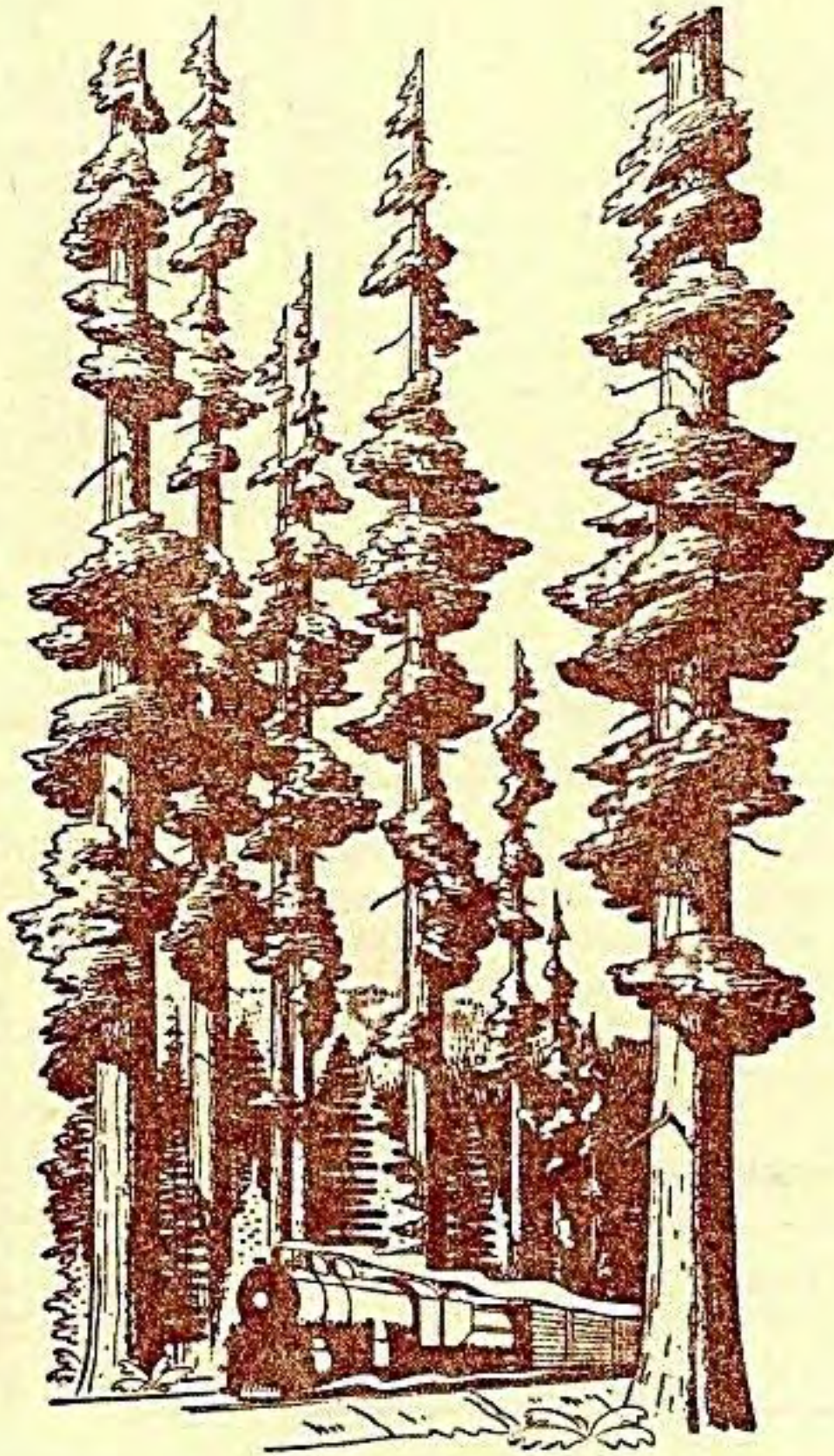

TIME. From 12:01 midnight to 12:00 noon (A.M. time) is shown in light faced figures, time from 12:01 noon to 12:00 midnight (P.M. time) is shown in dark faced figures.

CHILDREN under 5 years of age free, when accompanied by parent or guardian, 5 years of age and under 12, one-half fare; 12 years of age or over, full fare.

ADJUSTMENTS OF FARES. In cases of dispute with Conductors or Agents, pay the fare required, take receipt and communicate with F. E. Watson, General Passenger Agent, 600 Tribune Tower, 13th and Franklin Sts., Oakland 12, Calif.

LIMIT OF TICKETS. Tickets must be used within limits printed thereon.
REDEMPTION OF TICKETS. Tickets redeemed under tariff regulations.
BAGGAGE MAXIMUMS. No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds in weight, or 72 inches in greatest dimension, or single shipment exceeding \$2,500.00 in value will be checked. Free allowance subject to tariff stipulations.

BAGGAGE from San Francisco will be checked at the Ferry Bldg., Foot of Market St. and baggage checked to San Francisco, will be delivered at this terminal.

LIABILITY LIMITED. Excess value to be declared and paid for when checking.

LOST ARTICLES. Inquire at Lost and Found Bureau at ticket office at San Rafael or trainmaster's office at Eureka.

RAILROAD NOT RESPONSIBLE for unchecked articles left in stations or cars.

HAND BAGGAGE IN PULLMANS is restricted to what can be conveniently placed in berth or seat occupied by passenger.

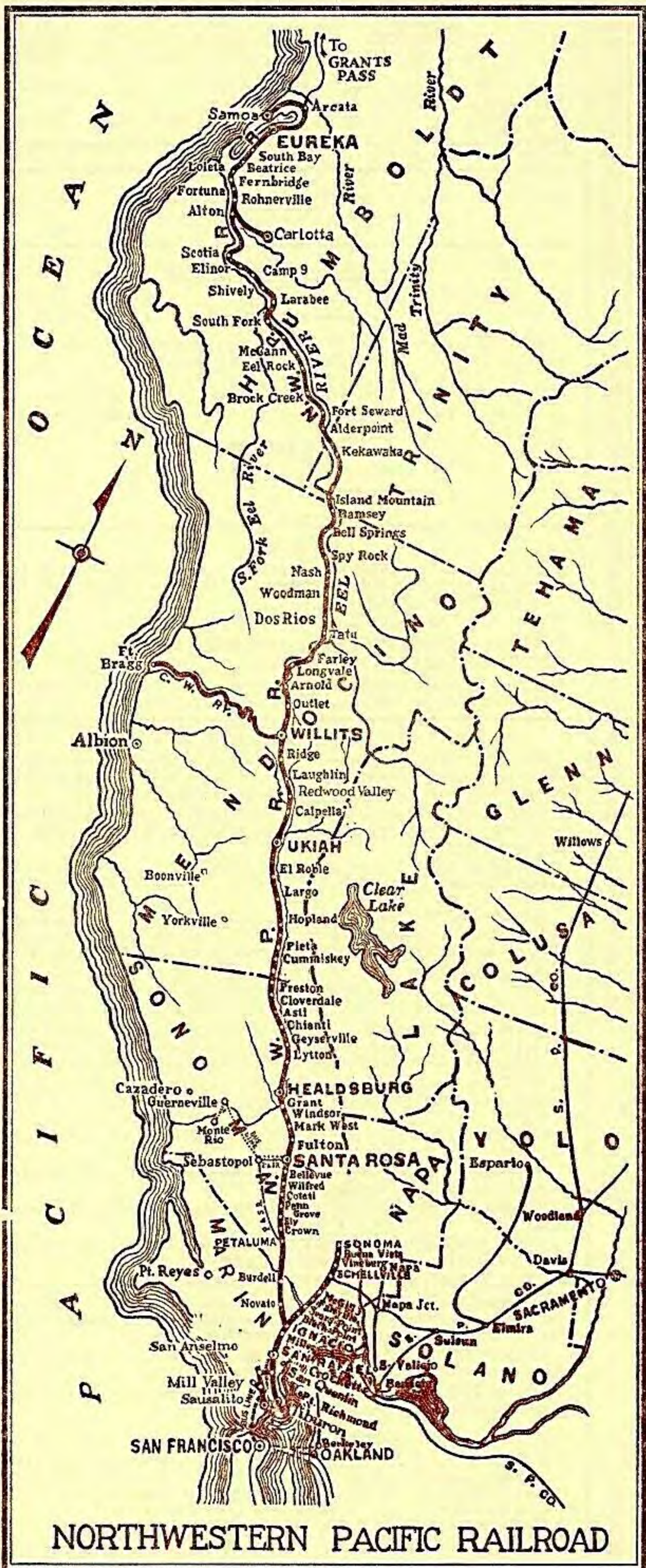
REDCAP SERVICE. Porters will assist passengers with hand baggage.
