


Indication: Proceed approaching next signal at limited speed.


Indication: Proceed; limited speed within Interlocking Limits.


Indication: Proceed approaching next signal at medium speed.

DEFINITIONS

LIMITED SPEED:

A speed not exceeding

forty-five miles per hour.

MEDIUM SPEED:

A speed not exceeding

one-half authorized speed, but not exceeding thirty

miles per hour.

SLOW SPEED:

A speed not exceeding

fifteen miles per hour.

RESTRICTED SPEED:

A speed not exceeding that which will enable a train to stop short of train a he a d, obstruction or

a head, obstruction or switch not properly lined and to look out for broken rail, but not exceeding

fifteen miles per hour.

NOTE 1-Speed restrictions apply to entire train.

NOTE 2—Automatic signals are designated by number plate.
