## RULES

Depot officers, their assistants and trainmen, when on duty, must direct passengers to their proper trains.

All employes are required, when on duty, to wear the uniform and badges prescribed by the Superintendent; no employe will be allowed to absent himself from duty without permission from the head of the department in which he is employed.

Gentlemanly deportment is required of all employees of the Salt Lake City Union Depot and Railroad Company. Incivility will not be tolerated. All employees are requested to answer inquiries correctly and promptly, to aid passengers and the public doing business with the Salt Lake City Union Depot and Railroad Company, or the individual carriers entering the depot. Prompt report should be made to the Superintendent of any questions which may arise with the traveling public or with patrons of the individual lines, giving such details as will permit prompt handling of the situation.

Baggage and express trucks, when not in use, must be kept "blocked." In moving baggage or express trucks, one person at least must be at the forward end of the truck.

The refuse or sweepings from dining cars, private cars, or coaches, must not be deposited on Union Passenger Station grounds.

All employes of the different roads will be promptly reported to their respective Superintendents for any violation of rules and regulations of this company, or for any disregard of the instructions of its officers.

The Salt Lake City Union Depot and Railroad Company will not be responsible for any baggage left on the platform. No baggage will be received in the baggage room unless checked. Baggage not removed within twenty-four hours after arrival shall be subject to a charge by this company in accordance with Baggage Tariff. Valises and small packages will be sent to check stand in baggage room.

Trains have no time-table superiority between First South and Ninth South Streets, Salt Lake Union Depot Company's Yard, Salt Lake City. Yard crews and others occupying these tracks must make way for passenger trains without unnecessarily delaying them. In case of collision responsibility rests with approaching train or engine.

Any irregularities must be reported to the Superintendent without delay.
