Some Thanksgiving Travel Tips from Amtrak

The Thanksgiving holiday is the single busiest travel period of the year. In Amtrak's Northeast Corridor alone, we will carry over 250,000 people during the holiday weekend. On the two busiest days—Wednesday and Sunday—Northeast Corridor trains carry almost double the amount of people that travel on an average day. To meet this challenge, we will operate every available car and schedule more than **100 extra trains** during this period. We also add to our capacity by borrowing commuter train equipment from other railroads to operate extra trains.

During the peak travel hours, Amtrak trains and stations will be very crowded and seats may be hard to come by on some trains. We will make every effort to speed your trip and see to your comfort, but please forgive us if the holiday travel rush causes you any inconvenience.

To make your Thanksgiving trip as smooth as possible, here are some holiday travel tips:

PLAN TO AVOID THE RUSH

The busiest Thanksgiving travel periods are Tuesday, Wednesday, and Sunday afternoons. If possible, avoid traveling at all on Wednesday and Sunday, as well as on Thursday morning. All services will be very crowded on those days. Other than Thanksgiving Day, morning trains will not be as busy as those in the afternoon and evening. You'll also save money if you travel on Tuesday, Friday, or Saturday when excursion fares are available.

CONSIDER RESERVED SEAT SERVICES

Although many Northeast Corridor trains are unreserved, there are still a variety of services which offer reservations. You will be assured a seat and will find these services to be generally less crowded than unreserved trains. You may reserve a seat on all Metroliner trains, in First Class Club Service, or on our New England Express trains, as well as on selected Empire Service trains. These trains often sell out in advance, so plan to purchase your ticket as soon as possible. (P.S. **Now** is a good time to consider making your reservations for Christmas holiday travel!)

PURCHASE YOUR TICKETS IN ADVANCE

Avoid long holiday lines at the station by purchasing round-trip tickets before the day you travel. Amtrak tickets are sold by most travel agents and also at downtown Amtrak Travel Centers in New York, Philadelphia, and Washington. At most Northeast Corridor stations, Self-Serve Ticketing machines are available for ticket purchases with a major credit card.

Speed your return journey by purchasing round-trip tickets. Please be sure you have the correct ticket for your journey. Excursion fare tickets are **not valid** on November 27, 28 and December 1.

ARRIVE AT THE STATION EARLY

During the holiday, we recommend you plan to arrive at the Amtrak station at least 30 minutes before your scheduled train departure, and add another 30 minutes if you need to purchase tickets. Check video monitors and train information boards to determine the departure gate of your train. Club Service passengers are invited to relax and wait for their train in the first class Metropolitan Lounge in New York and Washington.

LISTEN CAREFULLY FOR BOARDING ANNOUNCEMENTS

Be sure that the train you are boarding will stop at your intended destination. Extra trains may not go to all stations. If you are still in doubt, check with the conductor before you step onto the train.

PLANNING TO MEET SOMEONE?

Inform your party not only of your expected arrival time, but also the train number (in this timetable). Set a meeting place away from the immediate gate area—this makes it easier to locate your party in case your train is delayed or if you come in on an earlier or extra train. (Near the train information board in the main waiting room is an easy-to-find meeting place).

Holiday Fares

Excursion fares are not valid Wednesday, Thursday, and Sunday

Northeast Corridor discount fares are not valid for travel on Wednesday, November 27; Thursday, November 28; and Sunday, December 1. Passengers who attempt to use excursion fare tickets on these peak days will be required to pay an extra fare on board the train. Regular full fares apply on Wednesday, Thursday, and Sunday.

Travel Off-Peak and Save

By traveling on Tuesday, Friday, or Saturday, you can avoid the peak travel days and save up to 35% on round-trip fares. And on Friday, November 29 and Saturday, November 30, you'll find special discounts for all Metroliner travel.

General Information

ALCOHOL

Passengers are not permitted to consume their private stock of alcoholic beverages in a public area. Only sleeping car accommodations for which a passenger has a valid ticket are considered non-public areas.

BAGGAGE

Checked Baggage Service: At stations and on trains with baggage checking facilities, fare-paying passengers with valid tickets may check free of charge up to three pieces not exceeding 75 lbs. each or 150 lbs. total weight. Baggage in excess of the free allowance is subject to a surcharge. Sturdy boxes and cartons securely fastened, able to withstand normal handling, not exceeding 50 lbs. may be accepted. Baggage checked less than 30 minutes prior to departure may be delayed. Passenger's name and address must be attached to each piece.

Carry-On Baggage: All Amtrak trains can accommodate two pieces of carry-on baggage per passenger. Baggage of reasonable size, weight, and quantity may be carried aboard Amtrak trains. Amtrak disclaims liability for loss or damage to carry-on baggage.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Amtrak will refund the unused value of original tickets presented in accordance with refund policies (see refunds), with the following exceptions. For sleeping accommodations (including Auto Train or Club Service Conference Room accommodations), if tickets are not cancelled at least 48 hours prior to departure, a substantial penalty will be assessed against the refund due. For Club Service seating accommodations, if tickets are not cancelled at least one hour prior to departure, a penalty of 50 percent of the accommodation charge will be assessed against the refund due. The penalty will not be assessed in the event a passenger chooses to cancel travel on account of the train being delayed two hours or more at the boarding station. Cancellation of reservations does not generate a refund; the actual unused ticket must be submitted.

COMMENTS ON SERVICE

We encourage you to give us the benefit of any comments, compliments, or suggestions you may have regarding Amtrak service. Send comments to Office of Customer Relations, Amtrak, Washington Union Station, 60 Massachusetts Avenue, N.E., Washington, DC 20002. (Note: Include your ticket receipt.)

CONNECTING TRAINS

Amtrak does not normally guarantee connections of less than 60 minutes. Consult Amtrak or your travel agent if your planned itinerary includes a connection of less than one hour.

A guaranteed connection *does not* ensure that such a connection will always be made. In the case of a missed guaranteed connection, Amtrak will provide alternate transportation on Amtrak, another carrier, or overnight hotel accommodations, at Amtrak's discretion.

CREDIT CARDS

Amtrak accepts American Express, Carte Blanche, Diners Club, Discover, Japan Credit Bureau (JCB), MasterCard, Visa and Air Travel Card (ATC), at all ticketing locations. These cards (except JCB) are also accepted on board for the sale of tickets (excluding commuter ticket step-up fares, which must be paid by cash) and dining car meals (except ATC and JCB).

EN ROUTE UPGRADING OF ACCOMMODATIONS

Sleeping car, Club Service and Custom Class accommodations may be purchased on board trains if unsold space is still available. Passengers wishing to purchase an upgrade of accommodations should consult the Conductor or Chief of On Board Services.

LIABILITY

The schedules and services shown in this timetable are not guaranteed, are subject to change without notice, and form no part of the contract between Amtrak and a passenger. Amtrak disclaims liability for inconvenience, expense, or damage resulting from errors in this timetable, shortage of equipment, or delayed trains, except that when such a delay causes a passenger to miss a guaranteed connection Amtrak will provide alternate transportation on Amtrak, another carrier, or overnight hotel accommodations at Amtrak's discretion.

LOST ARTICLES

Please report misplaced articles left on trains or in stations to a station baggage agent as soon as possible. Every effort will be made to recover the item promptly. Amtrak disclaims liability for lost or misplaced articles.

LOST, STOLEN OR DESTROYED TICKETS

Amtrak disclaims liability for lost, stolen or destroyed tickets. Refunds will not be authorized.

LUGGAGE CARTS

Many stations have free luggage carts. However, at some major stations luggage carts are available for \$.75. Deposit \$1.00 in the cart vending machine and \$.25 is refunded upon return to a vending machine.

PERSONAL CHECKS

Amtrak does not accept personal checks in California, except from customers age 65 or older. In all other states, Amtrak accepts personal checks of \$25.00 or more from customers who provide a valid photo identification and one of the credit cards noted. Checks must also be for the amount of purchase, contain a current address (P.O. Box addresses not acceptable) and preprinted name. To obtain a refund at a station on tickets purchased by check, please provide a copy of both sides of the cancelled check.

PETS

Certified guide or service animals accompanying blind, deaf or disabled passengers are the only animals permitted on Amtrak trains. Documentation is required.

RADIOS

To maintain a pleasant atmosphere for all passengers, Amtrak requires that earphones be used when listening to radios, tape players, etc.

REDCAP SERVICE

Baggage assistance is provided free of charge by Redcaps at most major stations. All baggage handled by Redcaps is protected by a claim check. Amtrak recommends that passengers accept assistance only from a uniformed Redcap and that they demand claim checks for each piece. Items handled by Redcaps are *not* checked baggage and passengers are responsible for them once loaded onto trains.

REFUNDS

Most refunds can be handled at Amtrak ticket offices upon presentation of original tickets but exceptions do exist; consult Amtrak. Refunds of partially used special fare or excursion fare tickets may be limited. Tickets purchased at a travel agency must *usually* be returned to the agency; however, if a refund is required because of a service disruption, or downgrade of sleeping, club or custom class accommodations, Amtrak will process tickets issued by travel agencies. RESERVATIONS

Amtrak toll-free reservation and information numbers listed on the cover are available 24 hours a day. Special teletypewriter service for deaf persons is available seven days a week, 24 hours a day.

Reservations are required for all club, custom class and sleeping car accommodations. Reservations for coach travel are required on all trains shown in this timetable as "All-Reserved Trains." **Seating in trains with unreserved coach service is not guaranteed.** Reservations are subject to cancellation if tickets are not purchased by the date assigned when reservations are made, or if unticketed passengers board at locations other than those reserved.

If Your Plans Change: If your travel plans change, please contact your travel agency or Amtrak at 1-800-USA-RAIL. This will enable us to accommodate other customers who are unable to reserve space. Your assistance will be greatly appreciated. Penalties may apply for non-cancellation.

SMOKING

Smoking is permitted only in sleeping cars, designated coaches, and designated sections of lounges and Metroliner Service club cars. No smoking is permitted in diners, custom class, cafes, half-clubs and portions of lounge cars. Pipes and cigars are prohibited. Amtrak requests smokers to be considerate of other passengers.

SPECIAL ASSISTANCE

Disabled, elderly and other passengers needing special assistance, such as a wheelchair, special food service (72 hours advance notice needed) or baggage assistance, must call Amtrak at 1-800-USA-RAIL as much in advance of travel as possible.

TICKETS BOUGHT ON TRAINS

A \$5.00 penalty per person is assessed for tickets bought on trains when the boarding ticket office is open at the time of departure. Discounted, excursion or round-trip tickets cannot be purchased on trains, with limited exceptions.

Northeast Corridor Travel**

**Amtrak Has Just Introduced Some
Important Changes to Excursion Fares
In the Northeast Corridor:**

• **NEW METROLINER WEEKEND FARES**

Reduced fares are now available for Saturday and Sunday travel on all Metroliner Service trains both one way and round trip. Reservations are required and seats may be limited. Holiday exceptions: weekend Metroliner fares are not valid on Sunday, December 1; but reduced fares are also available all day on Friday, November 29.

• **TIME-OF-DAY RESTRICTIONS CHANGED TO 11 AM-7 PM**

Excursion fares between selected Northeastern cities carry time restrictions on peak travel days. Those time restrictions have recently changed. Now, wherever time restrictions apply (CRT2, CRT3, URT2 fares), those excursion fares are not valid on trains scheduled to leave the passenger's departure station between **11 AM and 7 PM**.

For travel to/from New England points, these time restrictions apply on **Fridays and Sundays**.

For travel locally between the New York area and the Washington, DC, area, including Philadelphia, and for travel within the Hudson Valley, time restrictions now apply on **Fridays** only.

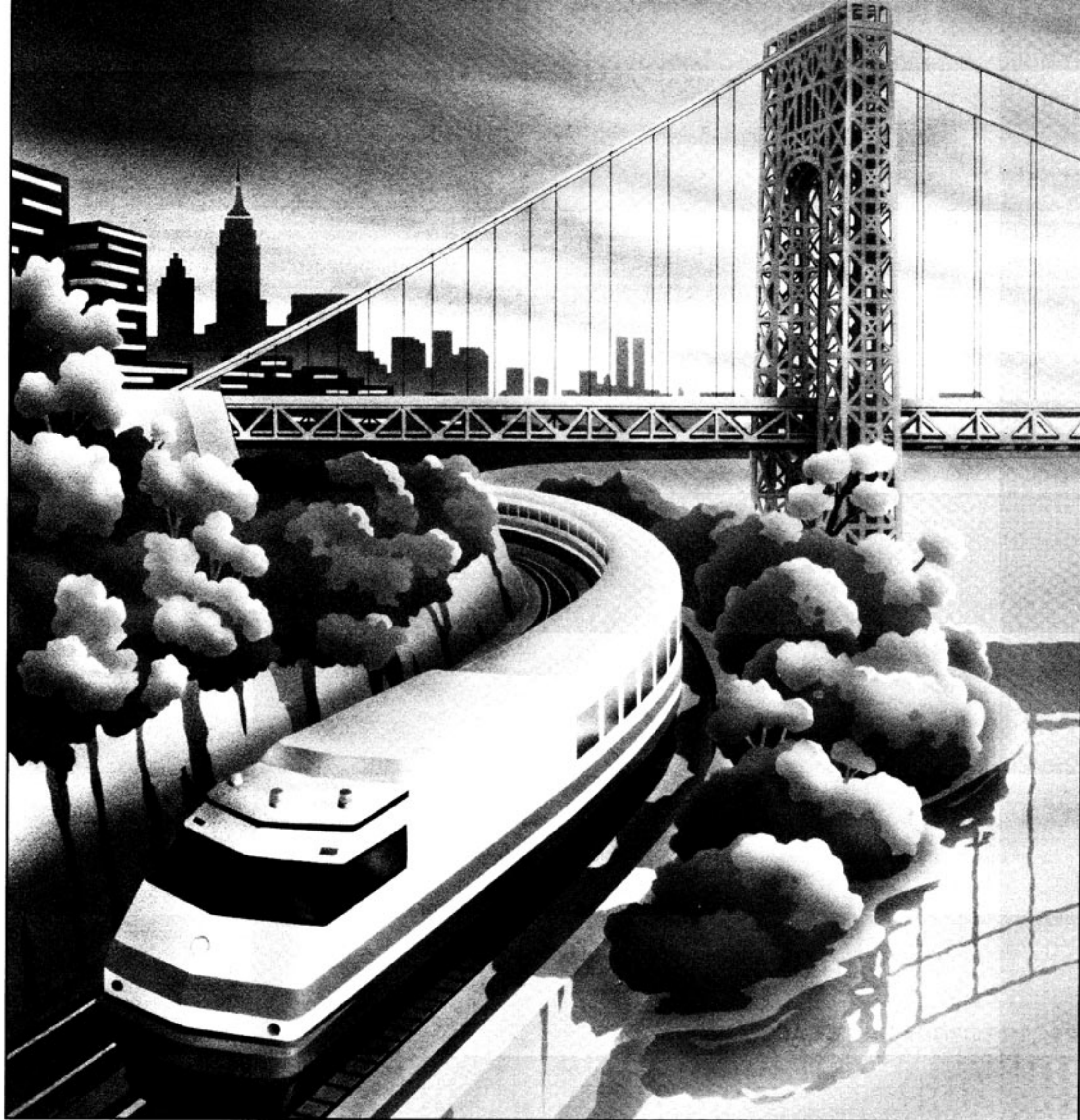
Holiday exceptions: Northeastern excursion fares are not valid all day on November 27, 28 and December 1, and future peak holiday travel dates; but excursion fares are valid all day with no time restrictions on November 29.

• **WASHINGTON/BALTIMORE TIME RESTRICTIONS**

Excursion fare travel between the Washington/Baltimore areas and New York area stations once again is subject to time-of-day restrictions. Excursion fare tickets between these points are not valid for travel on trains scheduled to leave the passenger's departure station between **11 AM and 7 PM** on **Fridays**.

Check with an Amtrak agent for complete excursion fare information.

Holiday blackout restrictions apply to Northeast Corridor excursion fares all day on November 27, 28 and December 1, and for peak travel days of other major holidays. Excursion fare tickets are not valid for travel on those dates.
