#### SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS.

- 1. All trains between Maroa and Decatur Junction will be governed by Decatur Junction Time Table and Transportation Dept. Rules of the Illinois Central Railroad.
  - 2. All North bound trains are superior to trains of the same class in the opposite direction.
- 3. Trains in the same direction must be spaced ten (10) minutes apart except where the movements are controlled by some form of block signals.
- 4. Third class and extra trains may run ahead of overdue second-class trains without train orders, but will keep advised of their movements so far as possible, and allow them to pass without delay.
  - 5. Trains displaying signals arriving at Decatur Junction or North Junction will display same to Decatur.
  - 6. Train registers are kept at Maroa and Decatur.
- 7. Enginemen, on south bound Indiana Division, and Penna Line Trains will sound four short blasts of whistle approaching Decatur Junction indicating train for diverging route.
- 8. The Junction Switch at Decatur Junction will be handled by the switch tender, and when not in use must be set and locked for the Clinton District main track.
- 9. Clearance Card (Form 44), must be obtained by south-bound Penna Line trains at Maroa and by north-bound Penna Line trains at Decatur before proceeding.
- 10. Trains must approach the Penna Line Junction at Marca, North Junction and Decatur Junction, prepared to stop expecting to find the main track occupied.

North-bound Clinton District trains must stop within 800 feet of the Decatur Junction switch. South-bound trains must stop within 800 feet of the switch at North Junction. Penna Line, Peoria and Havana District trains must stop before entering upon the Clinton District main track and not proceed unless the switches are right and the track clear.

- 11. North-bound trains will reduce speed to 20 miles per hour when passing over the switch at South Junction.
- 12. Yard Limit Stations-Decatur.
- 13. Bulletin Boards-Maroa and Decatur.
- 14. Railroad Crossing-Not interlocked. Decatur, Wabash Ry.
- 15. Water Station-Decatur.
- 16. Standard Clock—Decatur Telegraph Office.
- 17. Telephones connected with dispatcher's circuit are located as follows: Emery, north end of siding. Decatur, North Wye Crossover, and Yard Office, South Junction, in switch tender's cabin.

### DOUBLE TRACK RULES.

The double track extends from North Junction to South Junction. All trains will take the right-hand track.

Trains may use the double track between North Junction and South Junction without orders.

Inferior trains may run ahead of superior trains on the double track without train orders.

The Junction switch at North Junction will be handled by trainmen and when not in use must be left set and locked for the south-bound main track.

The Junction switch at South Junction will be handled by switch tenders and when not in use must be left set and locked for the north-bound main track.

Trains must approach the junction switches at the end of double track prepared to stop and know that the switches are in proper position and track clear before proceeding.

When passenger trains approach a station on double track about the same time, the south-bound train will go to the platform first.

A train must not pass between a station platform and another train which is receiving or discharging passengers.

When necessary to operate any portion of the double track as a single track it must be done only by authority of the Chief Train Dispatcher, or under protection as Provided in Rule 99.

### SOUTH JUNCTION BLOCK.

Between South Junction and Decatur Junction the movement of trains will be governed by block cards issued by the telegraph operator at Decatur.

South-bound trains will obtain block order Form SB at Decatur.

At the expiration of the time as shown on the block order, the order becomes void and of no effect, and the train holding the order must be clear of the block or protected by flag in accordance with Transportation Department Rule No. 99.

North-bound Trains must stop before fouling the switch at Decatur Junction and obtain block orderForm NB before proceeding.

All north-bound trains will report immediately on arrival at the telegraph office at Decatur.

Attention is further called to the fact that block order Form SB may provide for a meeting point at South Junction.

Conductors of south-bound trains must deliver their block cards to the telegraph operator at Decatur Junction on arrival.

Trains must run within the limits of the block prepared to stop unless the track is seen or known to be clear.
