



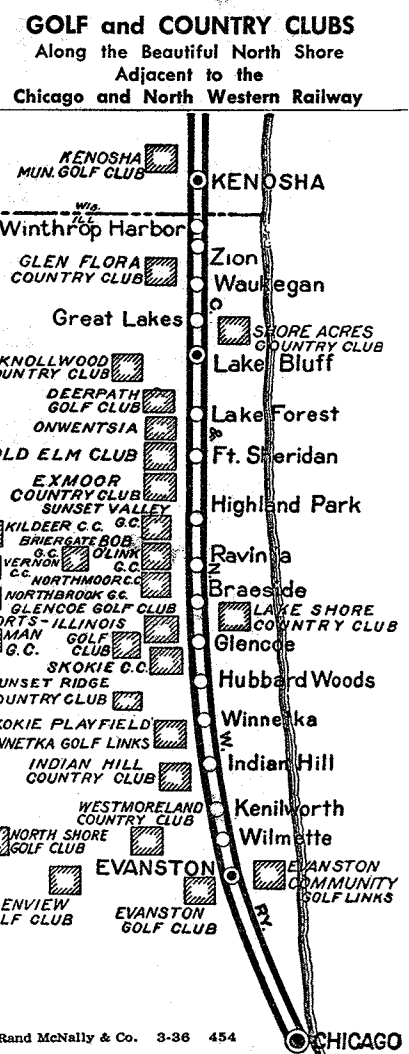

EXPLANATION OF REFERENCE MARKS. Runs also on Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's.

HOLIDAY SUBURBAN SERVICE. On holidays shown below Sunday train schedules will be in effect, except that trains Nos. 168, 218, 220 and 240 will NOT run.

PARLOR AND DINING CAR EQUIPMENT. ☆ Parlor Car on Nos. 152, 156, 158, 168, 206, 214, 216, 220, 240 and 400.

FOOTNOTES. M On Saturdays only stops at platform Milepost 34, eight-tenths of a mile north of North Chicago Station.

FOOTNOTES. N Does not carry passengers locally Evanston to Chicago; runs on center track.

FOOTNOTES. P Stops also except Saturdays at platform Milepost 34, eight-tenths of a mile north of North Chicago Station.

FOOTNOTES. Q Train stops on center track. V Stops on center track except Saturdays; on Saturdays stops on south-bound track.

FOOTNOTES. W Stops to discharge revenue passengers from Kenosha and beyond. X Indicates change from last issue of this folder.
