The applicable special service charge between stations where used for each assigned coach seat on the FLORIDA SPECIAL or the CHAMPIONS is 50¢ where the one-way adult coach fare is less than \$7.67; \$1.00 where the one-way adult coach fare is \$7.67 or more except is \$2.00 to destinations on the Pennsylvania Railroad. On the CITY OF MIAMI or SOUTH WIND the special service charge is \$1.00 where the one-way adult coach fare is less than \$10.00 and \$2.00 where the one-way adult coach fare is \$10.00 or more. Exception: Charge not applicable on intrastate traffic in Georgia and South Carolina nor when occupancy of seat begins and ends in Florida.
