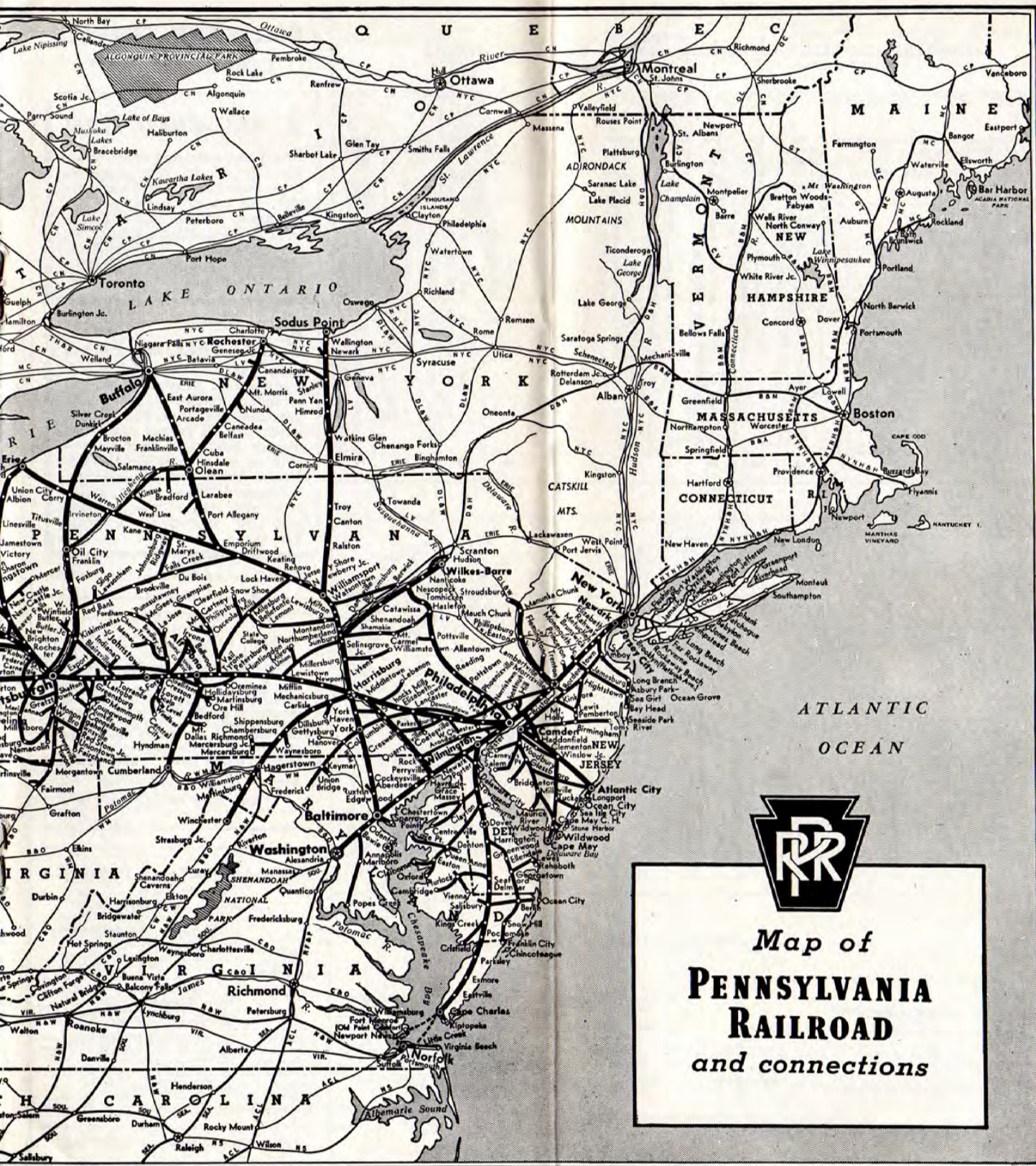

THE TIME from 12.01 a. m. to 12 o'clock noon, inclusive, is indicated by light-face type; from 12.01 p. m. to 12 o'clock midnight, inclusive, by dark-face type.

AIR-CONDITIONED TRAINS AND INDIVIDUAL SEAT COACHES—Air-conditioned equipment and individual seat coaches have been assigned to regular sections of certain trains. Every effort will be made to provide this equipment but the right is reserved to employ non-air-conditioned cars and non-individual seat coaches in such trains as may be necessitated by volume of traffic or operating contingencies.

ADJUSTMENT OF FARES—Should any misunderstanding arise with conductors or agents as to the proper fare or ticket privileges, please pay fare requested, take receipt and communicate with General Passenger Agent, Pennsylvania Station, Philadelphia 4, Pa.

CANCELLATION OF PULLMAN RESERVATIONS—When Pullman space, other than between New York-Washington and Florida points, December 15-May 15, is canceled prior to day of departure, refund on tickets may be obtained through the ticket agent. If space is canceled on the day of departure, consult agent with respect to handling tickets for any refund due or forward them direct to General Passenger Agent, Pullman Company, Merchandise Mart, Chicago 34, Ill.

CHILDREN—Under five years of age, free, when accompanied by parent or guardian; 5 years of age and under 12, one-half fare; 12 years of age or over, full fare.

BAGGAGE

DEFINITION OF CHECKED BAGGAGE—Wearing apparel, toilet effects (except liquids) and personal effects—necessary or appropriate for the wear, use, comfort and convenience of the passenger for the purpose of his journey, and not intended for other persons nor for sale. Money, jewelry, silverware, negotiable papers and like valuables, liquids, fragile or perishable articles, radios and household goods must not be included in checked baggage—the railroads will not be responsible for such articles.

MARKING FOR IDENTIFICATION—Mark or tag each piece with your name and address and place your name and permanent address inside each piece, whether it is checked or carried with you on the train.

FORWARDING—Passengers are urged to check baggage in advance so that it may be forwarded on a preceding train. Every effort will be made to facilitate the handling of baggage, but the Railroad cannot guarantee to forward on same train with owner, nor the arrival time at destination.

CHECKING ALLOWANCE—One hundred and fifty (150) pounds of baggage not exceeding one hundred (\$100.00) dollars in value may be checked without additional charge for each adult passenger, and seventy-five (75) pounds not exceeding fifty (\$50.00) dollars in value for each child traveling on a one-half fare ticket.

A small charge is made for weight over these amounts. Passengers also have the privilege of declaring excess value on their baggage at a nominal charge of fifteen cents for each additional \$100.00 or fraction thereof over that allowed on their tickets. Limit of valuation that may be declared by one passenger not to exceed \$2,500.00.

MAXIMUM WEIGHT, SIZE AND LIABILITY—No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds in weight or 72 inches in greatest dimension, or single shipment exceeding \$2,500.00 in value, will be checked. Free allowance and liability is subject to tariff stipulation as to contents, weight, value and size.

SPECIAL DELIVERY SERVICE—Before starting a trip passengers may telephone the Railway Express Agency or other authorized transfer company to call and pick up baggage and check through to home, hotel, etc., at destination—or if baggage is delivered at station, baggage checkman will on request check through to the local address, making collection of the delivery charge; or if desired, this charge may be paid to the transfer company on delivery at destination.

This service is convenient, relieves you of handling baggage at stations, and for a reasonable charge, places responsibility for the movement of your baggage to and from stations in the hands of an authorized transfer company.

DOGS and other small household pets are transported in baggage cars subject to tariff regulations. Dogs, cats or other small animals (not venomous, odoriferous or otherwise objectionable) when carried in baskets or containers, may be taken by purchasers of Pullman private rooms into the rooms they occupy, subject to established regulations. Dogs may be on leash and muzzled instead of in containers.

SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR CHECKING HAND-BAGS

At Chicago—Passengers holding through tickets may on arrival in Chicago, deliver their hand baggage to Parmelee Company's Agent and secure claim check. The baggage will be transferred to the parcel room of station from which departure will be made and will be available on presentation of the claim check, if they have not less than three hours between trains. On presentation of transfer coupon, the charge is only 15c for each piece including parcel room fee for the first 24 hours.

Bags will also be checked and delivered by The Parmelee Company to any home, hotel, club or office address in Chicago at the regular transfer charge.

Check at Parcel Room of one Philadelphia Station, call for at another Philadelphia Station—Hand baggage may be checked at the Parcel Room at North Philadelphia, Pennsylvania Station (30th St.) or Broad Street Station, and called for at any other of these stations. There is no additional charge.

SPECIAL SERVICE CHARGE FOR SEAT RESERVATIONS ON THE TRAIL BLAZER, THE JEFFERSONIAN AND THE SOUTH WIND

Each passenger occupying a reserved coach seat in The Trail Blazer (Trains 76 and 77); The Jeffersonian (Trains 64 and 65) and The South Wind (Trains 303 and 304), is required to surrender a special service charge ticket reading between the points where the passenger occupies a reserved coach seat, in addition to regular local or interline coach passenger ticket.

The service charge is \$1.00 (plus Federal Tax) for each seat whether it be occupied by adult or child of any age.
