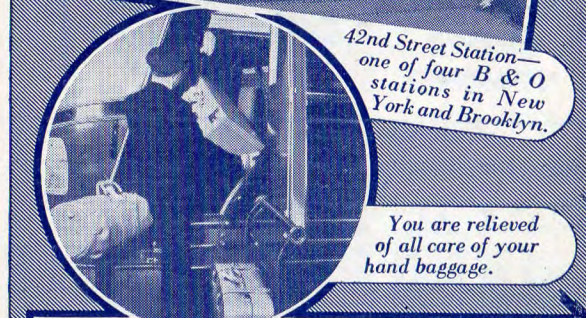
Attendants will gladly assist you to transfer hand luggage from 42nd Street Station to Grand Central Terminal, New York City.
