

Metrolink Regional Rail Service

Metrolink operates regional rail service on six routes in the greater Los Angeles area. Five of these routes radiate from Los Angeles Union Station, while the sixth connects San Bernardino and Riverside with Orange County.

Ventura County Line: Eight weekday-only trains operate in each direction on the Ventura County line. Most trains operate during peak hours, with a limited amount of off-peak service. Most service operates between Moorpark or Chatsworth and Los Angeles, although two round trips serve Oxnard and Camarillo. Trains serve all Amtrak stops along the line, as well as other Metrolink-only stops (see map).

Santa Clarita Line: Ten weekday trains operate in each direction on the Santa Clarita line. Most operate during peak hours, with limited off-peak service. Trains operate to/from Santa Clarita or Princesa, with five round trips extended to Lancaster. Saturday service consists of three round trips to Lancaster, and two additional round trips as far as Princesa. Trains stop at the Glendale Amtrak station. Amtrak Thruway buses to the San Joaquin Valley stop at the Metrolink station in Lancaster.

Additional service between Burbank and Los Angeles: In addition to the weekday round trips provided between Burbank and Los Angeles by the two above routes, additional trips operate between Burbank Airport or Burbank and Los Angeles.

San Bernardino Line: Twelve weekday round trips operate on the San Bernardino line. Eleven operate between San Bernardino and Los Angeles--providing all-day service including more frequent service during peak periods. The twelfth train operates only between Montclair and Los Angeles. Saturday service consists of four round-trips evenly spaced throughout the day operating between San Bernardino and Los Angeles. The San Bernardino terminal is also served by Amtrak long-distance trains and Amtrak Thruway bus service to the San Joaquin Valley. Amtrak Thruway buses also stop at the Claremont station.

Riverside Line: Seven westbound and six eastbound weekday trips operate on the Riverside line. Most trains operate during peak hours, with a limited amount of off-peak service. One off-peak round trip operates via Fullerton, rather than via East Ontario (see map). The Riverside Metrolink station is also served by Amtrak ThruWay buses to the San Joaquin Valley.

Orange County Line: Five northbound and six southbound weekday peak hour trains operate on the Orange County Line. Three in each direction operate to/from Oceanside, while the others operate to or from Irvine or San Juan Capistrano. Trains serve all Amtrak stops along the line, as well as other Metrolink-only stops (see map).

Inland Empire-Orange County Line: Four southbound and five northbound weekday-only peak hour trains operate on Metrolink's newest line. Three morning trains and one afternoon train operate from San Bernardino and Riverside to Irvine, while one morning train and four afternoon trains operate from Irvine to Riverside and all, except the last afternoon train, continue to San Bernardino.

How to use Metrolink

Metrolink can provide useful connecting service for many Amtrak trips in Southern California. There are many common service points indicated in black on the map. **Amtrak tickets are not valid on Metrolink trains, nor are Metrolink tickets valid on Amtrak trains or buses** (with a few exceptions for regular riders).

Metrolink passengers must purchase their tickets from ticket vending machines on the station platform, or from the ticket window at Los Angeles Union Station, before boarding the train. A ticket vending machine is located at the south end of Track 5 in Union Station for the convenience of transferring passengers. Ticket vending machines accept cash, VISA, MasterCard and ATM cards.

There are several types of tickets available from the vending machines, including one-way and round-trip tickets, 10 ride tickets and monthly passes. Fares are zone based, determined by the number of zones traveled. Transfer to the Red Line subway at Union Station is free with a valid Metrolink ticket. A 25% discount is available for travel during off-peak periods.

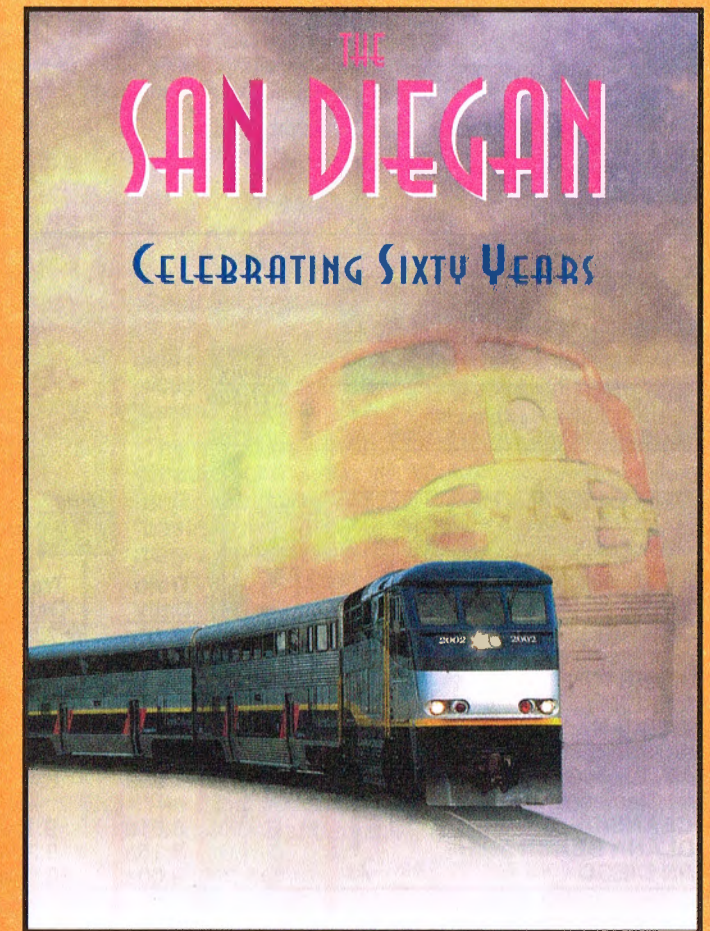

New Central Coast Stations

Two new San Diegan stations on the Central Coast should open in Summer 1998. Record rainfall from El Niño storms last winter delayed the opening of the **Goleta Station**, but it should be open by early summer. All San Diegan trains which serve Santa Barbara will also serve Goleta.

The Goleta station will be located at the north end of La Patera Lane, off Hollister Ave. It is a short bike ride from downtown or the University of California at Santa Barbara campus. The station is also convenient for travelers using the Santa Barbara/Goleta Airport.

Meanwhile, a new station has been constructed at **Guadalupe**. Guadalupe will be the train station for Santa Maria, as well as for local residents and visitors. The station is located at 330 Guadalupe St., in the center of town.

The Central Coast San Diegan and most Central Coast Thruway bus connections will stop at Guadalupe. Bus service will begin on May 17, 1998, while train service will begin at the same time the Goleta station opens.

New Pacific Class Service

Custom Class aboard the San Diegans is now **Pacific Class Service**. When you upgrade, you will ride in completely refurbished and upgraded coaches with personalized service and additional amenities.

The attendant provides complimentary service throughout the trip. In the morning, coffee, hot tea and chilled juice are offered with a selection of pastries and fruits. Afternoons, tea or coffee and finger sandwiches are served. In the evening, you'll enjoy a glass of wine or champagne, chilled juice, hot tea or fresh coffee, with cheese, crackers and fruit. Newspapers and magazines are always available.

There's an electrical outlet for a laptop computer at each seat, and the Pacific Class car has a GTE Railfone. Pillows and blankets are available, and seats have more legroom than regular coaches. The Cafe car is just steps away with hot and cold sandwiches and snacks.

Upgrade to Pacific Class Service for a nominal service charge when you buy your San Diegan ticket.

Two Noteworthy Anniversaries for the San Diegans

Amtrak California's San Diegans are celebrating 60 years of service in 1998. The service began in 1938 when the Santa Fe Railway introduced modern, streamlined equipment on the Southern California "Surf Line" between Los Angeles and San Diego. New cars and longer trains were added in the 1950's and 1960's as Southern California grew. In 1971 Amtrak assumed operation of the San Diegans and, in partnership with Caltrans, service was expanded from three to ten daily round trips.

1998 also marks the tenth anniversary of the San Diegan extension beyond Los Angeles to the San Fernando Valley, Ventura County and Santa Barbara. For the first time, San Diegan passengers would not have to change trains in Los Angeles. From one daily round trip in 1988, the Santa Barbara extension has grown to four trains, with one of these running all the way to San Luis Obispo.

More Central Coast Buses

Amtrak's popular Central Coast Thruway bus connections have been expanded to three daily round trips to supplement Central Coast San Diegan trains. The additional service offers greater flexibility and convenience, with more departure and arrival options. Your regular Amtrak ticket includes the Thruway bus connection.

When checked baggage service is not available, passengers may carry their baggage on-board, they may check their baggage ahead of time to travel on an earlier train, or they may check their baggage at time of travel and it will be carried on a later train. Checked baggage service is not available to or from unstaffed stations, nor is checked baggage service available at Van Nuys, Irvine or San Juan Capistrano.

Coaster
(Coast Express Regional Rail Service)

Coaster operates regional rail service between Oceanside and San Diego. Nine weekday-only round trips serve eight stations, including the Amtrak depots in Oceanside, Solana Beach and San Diego. There are two additional round trips on Friday evenings, and four round trips on Saturday. Coaster does not operate on Sundays or Holidays.

Amtrak tickets are not valid on Coaster trains, nor are Coaster tickets valid on Amtrak trains or buses.

Coaster passengers must purchase their tickets from ticket vending machines on the station platform before boarding the train. Ticket vending machines accept cash, VISA and MasterCard.

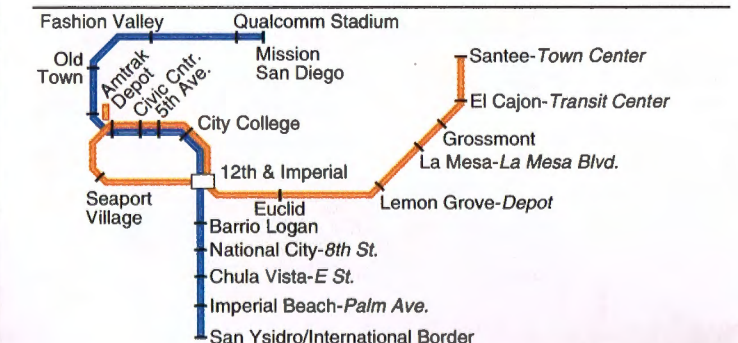
There are several types of tickets available from the vending machines, including one-trip, two-trip and 10-trip tickets, and monthly passes. Fares are zone based, determined by the number of zones traveled. All tickets, except monthly passes, must be validated before boarding the train.

San Diego Trolley

The San Diego Trolley operates light rail service on two lines serving the San Diego Amtrak Station. The Blue Line connects Qualcomm Stadium with San Ysidro (at the Mexican Border) via Mission Valley, Old Town, the Amtrak Station, Downtown San Diego, Barrio Logan, National City and Chula Vista. The Orange connects the Bayside area with America Plaza (across the street from the Amtrak Station), Downtown, Lemon Grove, La Mesa, El Cajon and Santee. Most service operates 5:00am to midnight, seven days a week, although service to Santee ends earlier in the evening.

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority operates three rail transit lines in the Los Angeles area. Each of these lines is described below. The Red Line terminates at Los Angeles Union Station, providing connections with Amtrak trains and buses.

Metro Red Line: The Red Line subway operates from Union Station through Downtown Los Angeles to Wilshire & Western. Trains operate from 5:00am to 11:15pm, seven days a week. Headways vary from 5 to 10 minutes.

Metro Blue Line: Blue Line light rail trains operate from 7th St./Metro Center (on the Red Line) to Downtown Long Beach. Trains operate from 5:00am to 11:20pm (southbound) or 10:00pm (northbound), seven days a week. Headways vary from 6 to 20 minutes.

Metro Green Line: Green Line light rail trains operate from Marine Ave. & Redondo Beach Ave. in the Redondo Beach-El Segundo area to I-105/I-605 in Norwalk. The Green Line connects with the Blue Line at the Imperial/Wilmington stop. Shuttle service is available from the Aviation Blvd. stop to Los Angeles International Airport. Trains operate from 4:30am to 11:30pm, seven days a week. Headways vary from 6 to 20 minutes.

- Unless otherwise noted, all trains and buses operate daily.
 - Trains which operate only on weekends and Holidays are shown with gray shaded background
 - XSSH - Operates Daily, except Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays.
 - SSH - Operates Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays only.
 - Holiday schedule operates on May 25, July 4 and September 7, 1998.
 - Lv - Leave, Ar - Arrive. When separate arrive and leave times are not shown stop is just long enough to allow loading and unloading of passengers.

Passengers without tickets, boarding buses at unstaffed stops, or boarding buses at staffed stops that are closed at time of departure, will be carried to the next open ticket office to purchase tickets from their boarding point (except on some bus routes, where tickets can be purchased from the bus driver).
