PASSENGERS ARE NOT ALLOWED to stand in vestibules or on platforms of cars. It is safer to remain seated while the train is in motion. CHILDREN. Children under five years old are carried free when accompanied by parents or guardian; those who have reached or passed their fifth birthday and are under twelve years of age require a half ticket; those who have reached or passed their twelfth birthday require an adult ticket. PULLMAN RESERVATIONS. Pullman reservations to points on these lines, or beyond, can be made by addressing any Agent or Passenger Representative of the Denver & Rio Grande Western. BEFORE BOARDING TRAINS ask the ticket agent, brakeman, or conductor whether the train stops at the station to which you may be ticketed. STOPPING TRAINS ON SIGNAL. Where trains are scheduled to stop only on signal, passengers on trains must give advance notice to conductor, and persons intending to board trains must advise agent to that effect, in order that necessary arrangement may be perfected. LOST ARTICLES. Agents will do all in their power to assist in the recovery of lost articles. Passengers should not only give full description of the property, but should state date of loss, number of train and whether left in coach or Pullman car. All lost articles found in coaches on Denver & Rio Grande Western are forwarded to C. W. Wiegand, Manager of Mail, Baggage and Express, Denver, Colo., and those found in sleeping cars are retained by the Pullman Co. Address the District Superintendent of that company at Denver, Colo., or Salt Lake City, Utah. No responsibility is assumed for unchecked articles left in stations or cars.
