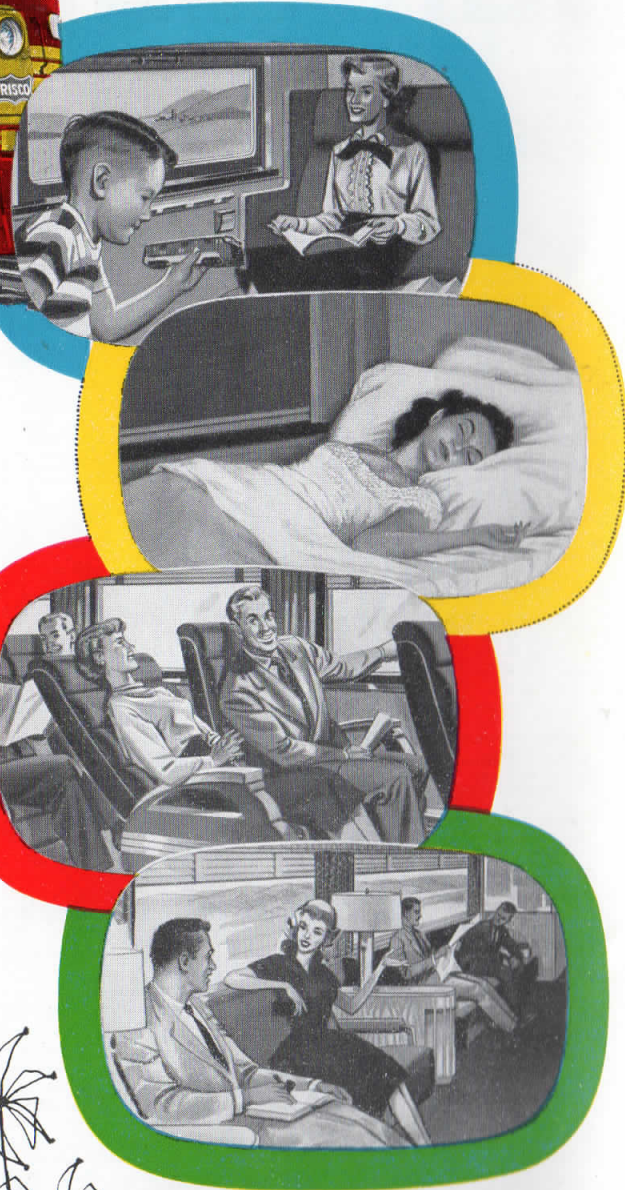

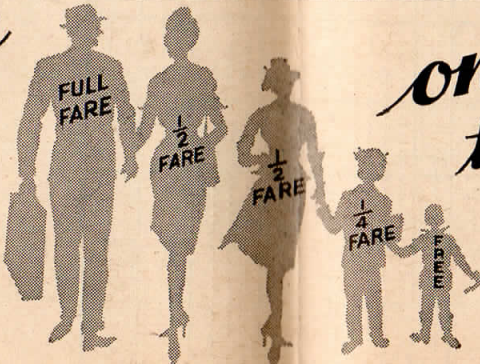

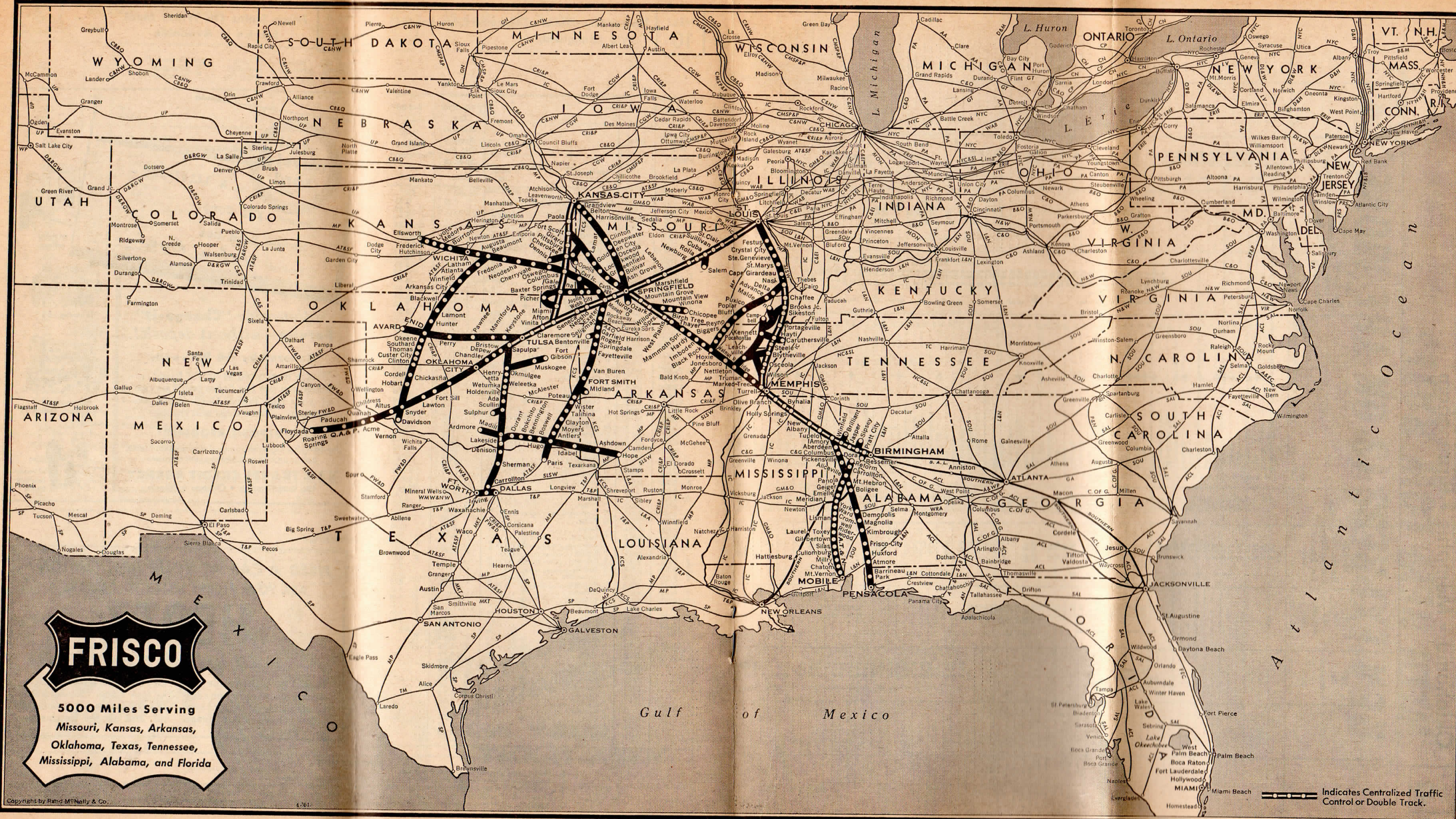

# General Information

## BAGGAGE

**Liberal Baggage Checking Privileges Are a Feature of Rail Passenger Service.** On payment of a nominal baggage checking service charge (25c per piece of hand baggage and 50c per trunk), the Frisco Railway and connecting railroads will check and transport your baggage in baggage cars. There is no additional charge for up to 150 pounds of baggage with value of not more than \$100.00 for each adult passenger and 75 pounds of baggage with value of no more than \$50.00 for child traveling on half-fare ticket. Baggage of greater weight or value than the amounts listed above will be handled on payment of the proper charges. The charge for additional weight depends on the weight and the distance baggage is to be checked. The charge for additional value is 25c for each \$100.00 or fraction thereof over the valuation allowed on tickets. No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds in weight, or 72 inches in greatest dimension, or single shipment exceeding \$2,500.00 in value, will be checked.

**Corpses.** A corpse (adult or child) will be transported in baggage service on one adult unrestricted ticket (not coach, or mixed class) with minimum as prescribed in tariff, when accompanied by an adult in charge, who must also be provided with proper transportation. Without escort, at double the regular adult unrestricted fare (not coach, or mixed class).

**Dogs and Other Small Household Pets** will be carried in baggage cars as provided in tariffs. Dogs, cats, birds and other small household pets (not venomous, malodorous or otherwise objectionable) may also travel with their owners in Pullman private room accommodations. Any animal traveling in a Pullman room must be in a basket or other container except that dogs may be leashed and muzzled instead of in containers. Such animals cannot be handled in chair cars or coaches.

**Trains Have Room for Baggage.** While it is wise to check unneeded baggage and thus make your trip simpler and more convenient, you can be sure that there will be room in or near your space on the train for the normal amount of hand luggage needed during your trip.

**Protecting Personal Effects.** You are cautioned to carefully look after your luggage and personal belongings when carried on trains and in stations. Before boarding or leaving trains, be sure you have all of your property. As a reminder, the protection of these possessions is your responsibility.

**Lost Articles.** Passengers who have lost articles on trains or at stations will please communicate with Delbert Fields, Passenger Traffic Manager, St. Louis 1, Mo., direct or through their nearest Ticket Agent.

## FARES AND TICKETS

**Adjustment of Fares.** In cases of difference of opinion with Conductors or Agents, please pay fare asked, take receipt and communicate with Delbert Fields, Passenger Traffic Manager, St. Louis 1, Mo.

**Children** under 5 years of age free, when accompanied by parent or guardian; 5 years of age and under 12, one-half fare; 12 years of age or over, full fare.

**Fares** between many points will be found in Table 54.

**Optional Routes** between Memphis, Tenn., and Jacksonville, Fla., and reverse. Round-trip tickets routed via Frisco to Birmingham, Ala., thence Southern Ry., will be honored as routed or via Southern Ry., via Chattanooga, Tenn., Asheville, N. C., and Savannah, Ga., or via Southern Ry., via Chattanooga, Tenn., Atlanta, Ga., and Macon, Ga. (Southern Ry. tickets will also be honored via Frisco).

### Redemption of Tickets:

Wholly unused tickets or wholly unused return portions of tickets reading between stations on the Frisco and sold at any station on the Frisco may be redeemed at any Frisco ticket office, if presented by original purchaser within one year from date of sale.

When presented by original purchaser within thirty (30) days from date of sale, wholly unused tickets sold at Frisco offices, to destinations on any other railroad, may be redeemed by ticket office which issued the ticket.

When presented by original purchaser within one year from date of sale, wholly unused tickets and wholly unused return portions of round-trip tickets sold at Frisco offices in Birmingham, Blytheville, Fort Smith, Kansas City, Memphis, Oklahoma City, St. Louis, Springfield and Tulsa, to destinations on any other railroad, may be redeemed at any Frisco ticket office in city in which ticket was sold.

Application for redemption of unused portions of other tickets should be made to Delbert Fields, Passenger Traffic Manager, Frisco, St. Louis 1, Mo.

**Stopovers.** Stopovers are permitted on practically all regular one-way and round-trip tickets, provided destination is reached prior to expiration of the ticket. Detailed information as to stopovers may be had from any Frisco ticket agent or from any of the representatives listed in Table 1 of this folder.

**Trains on Which Tickets Are Honored.** A ticket good for passage via Frisco is valid for transportation on any train authorized to carry passengers:

- (a) If the train is scheduled to stop at the destination of the passenger.
- (b) Or if the train runs via a direct route toward the destination and will carry the passenger to a junction point or an intermediate station at which the passenger can change to a train scheduled to stop at the destination.

## SCHEDULES

**Central Standard Time** is used except where otherwise shown.

**Condensed Schedules** in Tables 3, 4 and 5 are of assistance in planning trips on the Frisco and certain connecting lines. The type of cars carried on Frisco trains is also shown on these pages.

**Schedules Subject to Change.** Schedules herein are subject to change without notice, and the Frisco assumes no responsibility for errors in time tables, inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connections.

**Time** from 12:01 midnight to 12:00 noon (A. M. time) is shown in light figures, time from 12:01 noon to 12:00 midnight (P. M. time) is shown in dark figures.

**Western Union Telegraph Messages** can be sent from most Frisco stations. Also for the convenience of Pullman passengers, Pullman crews can provide blanks and dispatch messages from trains at certain way points. Charges for Western Union messages sent from trains can be collected at destination or billed direct to the sender's home or business address.

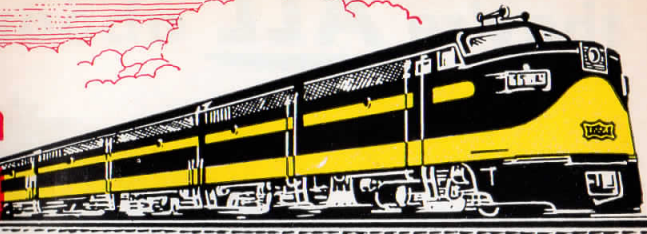
