#### INFORMATION

BUY TICKETS before boarding trains and avoid payment of extra charge

CHILDREN under five years of age when accompanied by parent or guardian, will be carried free, except that if the sole occupant of Sleeping Car space, they will be charged half railway fare and regular Sleeping Car fare; children between the ages of five and eleven years, inclusive, will be charged half fare, and children twelve years of age and over will be charged full fare.

ADJUSTMENT OF FARES—In case of misunderstanding with Conductors or Agents pay fare required, take receipt and communicate with General Passenger Agent.
