OPTIONAL HONORING OF TICKETS

Tickets reading via either the Northwestern Pacific or via the Pacific Greyhound Lines from and to stations between San Francisco and Ukiah, will be honored at the option of the passenger on Northwestern Pacific trains or Pacific Greyhound Lines buses, except:

- (a) The optional use of rail or bus will not apply locally within the interurban territory—each line will honor its own issue of tickets.
- (b) Holders of Northwestern Pacific monthly commutation tickets reading between San Francisco and stations north of San Rafael may use Pacific Greyhound Lines buses north of Sausalito or San Rafael, but in so doing must use Northwestern Pacific service between San Francisco and Sausalito or San Rafael.
- (c) Tickets reading via the Northwestern Pacific from and to stations between Ignacio and Kenwood will be honored on Pacific Greyhound Lines buses.

NOT RESPONSIBLE. This company is not responsible for errors in time tables, inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connections; schedules herein are subject to change without notice.

CHILDREN under 5 years of age free, when accompanied by parent or guardian; 5 years of age and under 12, one-half fare: 12 years of age or over, full fare.

ADJUSTMENTS OF FARES. In cases of dispute with Conductors or Agents, pay the fare required, take receipt and communicate with J. J. Geary, General Passenger Agent, 65 Market St., San Francisco.

TICKETS MUST BE USED WITHIN LIMIT. One way tickets are limited to 30 days from date of sale and stopovers are allowed at intermediate stations within limit, except that no stopovers are allowed in the interurban territory. Passengers holding Interline Tickets that expire at midnight of date punched in margin will be carried to destination on Northwestern Pacific R. R.

REDEMPTION OF TICKETS. Tickets unused or partly used will be redeemed under tariff regulations at proper value.

BAGGAGE MAXIMUMS. No single piece of baggage exceeding 250 pounds in weight, or 72 inches in greatest dimension, or single shipment exceeding \$2,500,00 in value will be checked. Free allowance subject to tariff stipulations as to contents weight, value and size.

LIABILITY LIMITED. Excess value to be declared and paid for at time of checking.

BICYCLES (not Motorcycles), BABY CARRIAGES, DOGS AND GUNS are transported in baggage cars subject to tariff regulations.

CHECKING TO AND FROM RESIDENCES. Agents for Red Line Transfer Co. collect baggage and checks on trains of Northwestern Pacific, and deliver baggage to residence. They are authorized to check baggage direct from residence.
