Buy Tickets before boarding trains and save money.

Children under five years of age free, when accompanied by parent or guardian: five years of age and under twelve, one-half fare; twelve years of age or over, full fare.

Adjustment of Differences—In event of any disagreement with the Conductor relative to tickets required, privileges allowed, etc., passengers should pay Conductor's claim, take his receipt and refer case for adjustment to the General Passenger Department.

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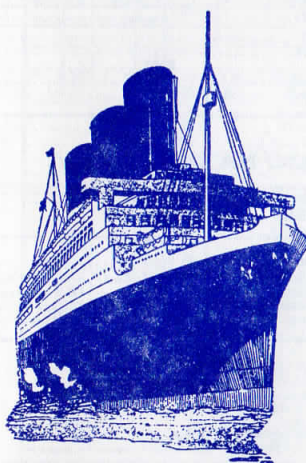
