## GENERAL INFORMATION

**Children** under five years carried free when accompanied by parent or guardian; five years old and under twelve, one-half fare; twelve years of age and over, full fare.

**Redemption of Tickets.** Tickets unused or partly used will be redeemed under tariff regulations, and should be forwarded to C. D. Bowman, General Passenger Agent, Tyler, Texas.

**Baggage** in Pullman cars is restricted to what can be placed conveniently in seat, berth or other space occupied by passenger. Baggage may be checked for transportation subject to tariff regulations governing allowances, valuations, contents, weight and size.

**Lost Articles** should be inquired for at office of C. D. Bowman, General Passenger Agent, Tyler, Texas. No responsibility is assumed for unchecked articles left in stations or cars.

**Dogs** and other household pets are transported in baggage cars subject to tariff regulations.

**All Trains** will stop at any station to discharge passengers holding revenue transportation issued by foreign lines.

**Stopovers** are allowed on one-way and round-trip tickets, on application to Conductor, provided destination is reached prior to expiration of the ticket. One-way tickets expire in 30 days; round-trip tickets in three months from date.

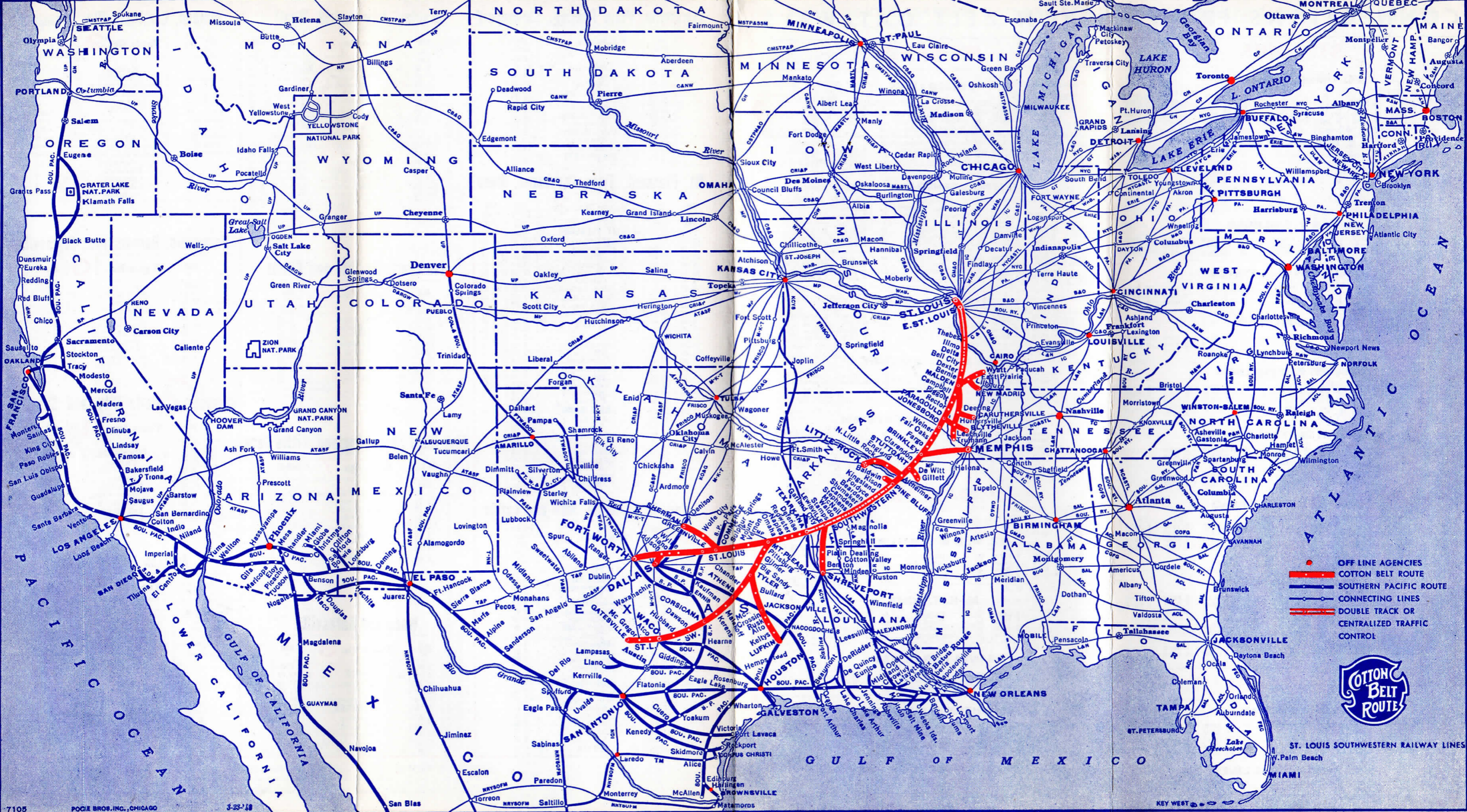
