GENERAL INFORMATION

These Time Tables show the time at which passenger carrying trains are scheduled to arrive at and depart from stations, and to connect with other trains, but the company will not be responsible for consequences arising from delays or from errors in these printed schedules. The company reserves the right without notice to discontinue trains, and change schedules, and to substitute equipment different from that shown herein, and will not be responsible for inconveniences or damage arising therefrom. The schedules of connecting lines appearing herein are published as public information; great care is taken to keep them correct, but the company will not be responsible for any errors or omissions therein.

Please buy tickets before boarding trains. Tickets must be used within limit. One way tickets bear limit of six months in addition to date of sale. Round trip tickets require completion of journey not later than midnight of expiration date as shown thereon. Stopovers are permitted at all points within limit of ticket.

Children under 5 years of age free, when accompanied by parent or guardian; 5 years of age and under 12, one-half fare; 12 years of age or over, full fare. Ask agent about the family fare plan.

Adjustment of Fares. In cases of dispute with Conductors or Agents, pay the fare required, take receipt and communicate with Mark Modglin, G. P. A., C. & S. Ry., Denver, or Y. E. Juge, R. M.-S., F. W. & D. Ry. Ft. Worth.

Redemption of Tickets. Tickets unused, or partly used, will be redeemed under tariff regulations at proper value.

Baggage. Baggage should be checked at least one hour before departure of the train on which it is desired that it move. Every effort is made for prompt handling of baggage, but we cannot guarantee that it will be forwarded on same train as passenger, nor can time of arrival be guaranteed. Up to 150 pounds of baggage may be checked on a regular adult ticket and 300 pounds on a family-plan ticket. Checkable hand baggage that may be conveniently carried by hand is subject to a 25¢ service charge, with a charge of 50¢ for trunks and checkable items other than hand baggage. Items offered for checking are subject to tariff stipulations as to contents, weight, value and size; service charges and excess value to be declared and paid for at time of checking. The following articles are among several that are too fragile or too valuable to be handled in checked baggage and will not be accepted: China, Glass or Silverware, Clocks, or Watches, Firearms (small) and Ammunition, Foodstuffs, Fragile Articles, Fruit (canned or fresh), Household Articles, Jewelry, Liquids of any kind, Money, Perishable Articles, Phonograph Records, Radios, Television Sets, Typewriters (Portable), Valuable Papers (Bonds, etc.), Paper cartons weighing more than 50 pounds. The carriers will not be responsible for loss, damage or injury to any such property contained in baggage.

Marking Baggage for Identification—Mark or tag each piece of your baggage with your name and address and place your name and permanent address inside each piece, whether the baggage is checked or carried with you on the train.

Bicycles (not Motorcycles), Baby Carriages, Dogs and Guns are transported in baggage cars subject to tariff regulations.

Hand-baggage in Pullman cars is restricted to what can be conveniently placed in the berth, seat or other accommodation purchased by the passenger.

Lost Articles should be inquired for through Mark Modglin G. P. A., C. & S. Ry., Denver, or Y. E. Juge, R. M.-S., F. W. & D. Ry., Ft. Worth, or nearest representative. No responsibility is assumed for unchecked baggage and articles or articles left in stations or cars.

OPTIONAL ROUTES

Between Denver and Billings—One-Way Tickets.—Tickets from or beyond Denver destined Butte or Helena, Mont. and beyond on the Northern Pacific and Great Falls, Mont., or beyond on the Great Northern (or the reverse) will be honored either via the C. & S.-C. B. & Q. through Wendover or via the C. B. & Q. through Alliance. Round Trip. Coupons of all round trip tickets good for travel between Denver and Billings will be honored either via C. & S.-C. B. & Q. through Wendover or via C. B. & Q. through Alliance regardless of route of ticket.

Between Denver and Rocky Mountain National-Estes Park—Rail coupons of round trip tickets destined Rocky Mountain National-Estes Park will be honored via Rocky Mountain Motor Company buses, or via C. & S. Ry., between Denver and Boulder, Loveland, Longmont or Ft. Collins, thence Rocky Mountain Motor Co. buses.

Between Denver and Boulder—Tickets good for travel via the Colorado and Southern Ry. between Denver and Boulder will be honored on the Denver-Boulder Bus Company buses, except local Coach tickets reading only between Denver and Boulder and tickets or coupons of through tickets sold at or destined to points north of Boulder.

Between Denver and Fort Collins—Tickets good for travel via the Colorado and Southern Railway will be honored on buses of the Colorado Transportation Co., between Denver and Fort Collins and intermediate points (table 2), except local tickets reading only between these stations and tickets or coupons of through tickets sold at or destined to points north of Ft. Collins.

Between Denver, Colorado Springs and Pueblo—Tickets good for travel via the Colorado & Southern Ry. will be honored on buses of the Denver-Colorado Springs-Pueblo Motorway between Denver, Colorado Springs and Pueblo, except local tickets or coupons of interline tickets reading only between those points.

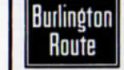
