





REDEMPTION OF TICKETS. Tickets unused or partly used will be redeemed under tariff regulations at proper value.

STOPEYES. Allowed on regular one way and round trip tickets within final limit at any station on notice to conductor.

ONE WAY TICKETS will be limited to one year in addition to date of sale. Local tickets are valid in either direction.

STOPPING TRAINS ON SIGNAL. Notice should be given ticket agent when passenger desires to board a train scheduled to stop only on signal. When there is no agent, passenger should display the signal provided for that purpose.

FOR YOUR PROTECTION MARK YOUR BAGGAGE, TO SHOW YOUR NAME AND PERMANENT ADDRESS.

BAGGAGE MAXIMUMS. No single piece of baggage, exceeding 300 pounds in weight, or 72 inches in greatest dimension, or single shipment exceeding \$250.00 in value, will be checked. Free allowances subject to tariff stipulations as to contents, weight, and size.

DECLARATION OF VALUE OF BAGGAGE. Passengers, when checking baggage or property, must declare IN WRITING the value of their baggage on form prescribed.

BAGGAGE FOR STATIONS WHERE NO AGENT IS ON DUTY must be claimed at the baggage car door immediately on arrival at that station, otherwise it will be carried to the first station where agent is on duty, and held for further orders.

BAGGAGE DELIVERY SERVICE. Through arrangement with responsible Transfer Companies in principal cities, baggage may be checked direct from larger stations to Steamship Piers and business or private addresses on payment of charges.

TRANSFER AT BOSTON. The Armstrong Transfer Co. with agents at railroad stations and steamship wharves transfer baggage to other railroad stations, steamship docks, hotels and residences. They also will check direct from residences and hotels to your destination.

DOGS will be checked in baggage service at tariff rates. They must be properly muzzled and provided with collar or harness of fitting color or harness on chain, or other strong leash, or else enclosed in crates. Small dogs, cats or other small animals (not vicious, odoriferous or otherwise objectionable) when carried in baskets or containers may be taken in coaches, also Pullman cars by purchasers of drawing rooms, compartments, or bedrooms.

ON MOTOR VEHICLES: Dogs, cats and other animals or birds will not be carried on motor coaches unless in suitable containers and the driver when, in the discretion of this company, there is no likelihood of annoying other passengers.

LOST ARTICLES to be inquired for at Travel Bureau, North Station, Boston, Mass. Applications for articles left in Pullman cars should be made at Pullman Co., North Station, Industrial Building, 12th floor, Boston, Mass. No responsibility is assumed for unchecked articles left in stations or cars.
