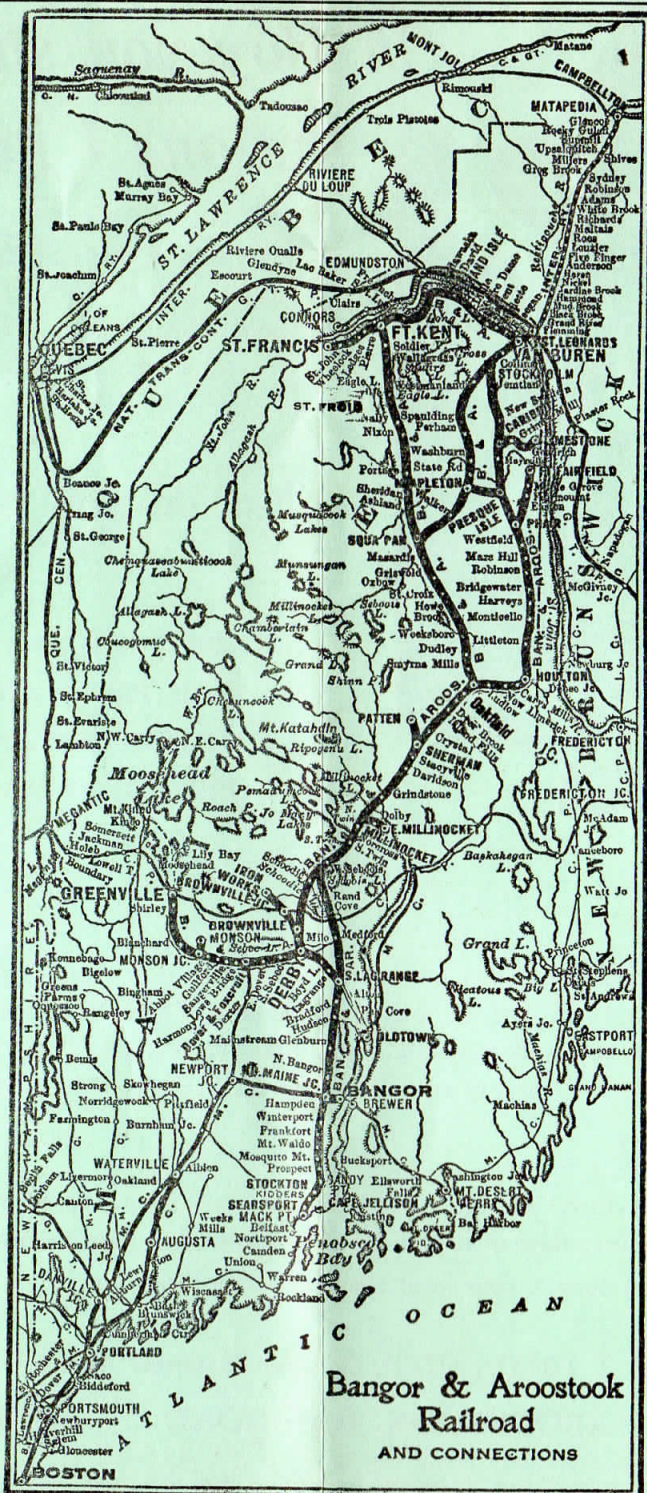

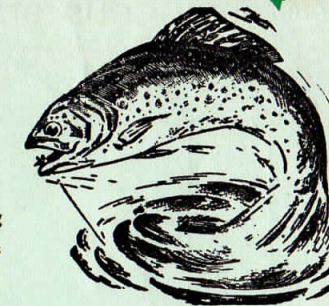

BRIEF SUMMARY MAINE 1941 FISHING LAWS

Open Seasons for Fishing

Table: Open Seasons for Fishing. Lists seasons for Salmon, Togue, Trout, White Perch, and Black Bass in various waters.

Brooks and Streams

Table: Brooks and Streams. Lists fishing seasons for Salmon, Trout, and Black Bass in streams.

Daily Bag Limits

Not more than 25 fish or 10 pounds in all Possession Limit at any one time not more than 10 pounds in all.

Sec. 22. Brooks and Streams Lakes, Ponds and Rivers

Table: Daily Bag Limits. Lists limits for Salmon, Togue, Trout, Black Bass, and White Perch in different water bodies.

LICENSES RESIDENT

Sec. 19. Fishing licenses are required for fishing in inland waters and transporting fish taken therefrom, by all residents over 18 years and all non-residents over 10 years of age.

LICENSES NON-RESIDENT

Table: License Fees. Lists fees for 15 day, 5 day, and 3 day licenses for residents and non-residents.

A 3 day license good for three days from date of purchase, may be obtained by any citizen of the United States.

ALL TRAINS Operate on Eastern Standard Time

NOT RESPONSIBLE. This company is not responsible for errors in time tables, inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connections; schedules herein are subject to change without notice.

BUY TICKETS before boarding trains and avoid payment of extra charge.

CHILDREN under 5 years of age free when accompanied by parent or guardian; 5 years of age and under 12, one-half fare; 12 years of age or over, full fare.

ADJUSTMENT OF FARES. In case of dispute with conductors or agents, pay the fare required, take receipt and communicate with the Passenger Department, Bangor, Maine.

REDEMPTION OF TICKETS. Tickets unused or partly used, will be redeemed under tariff regulations at proper value.

BAGGAGE MAXIMUMS. No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds in weight or single shipment 72 inches in greatest dimensions, or exceeding \$2500.00 in value will be checked. Free allowances subject to tariff stipulations as to contents, weight, value and size.

DECLARATION OF VALUE OF BAGGAGE. Passengers, when checking baggage or property, must declare IN WRITING the value of their baggage on form prescribed.

BAGGAGE FOR STATIONS WHERE NO AGENT IS ON DUTY must be claimed at the baggage car door immediately on arrival at that station, otherwise it will be carried to the first station where agent is on duty, and held for further orders.

ONE WAY TICKETS will be limited for passage to one year in addition to date of sale, and are good only in the direction in which they read.

BICYCLES (not Motorcycles), BABY CARRIAGES, DOGS AND GUNS are transported in baggage cars subject to tariff regulations.

LOST ARTICLES to be inquired for at the office of the General Passenger Agent, Bangor, Maine.

NO RESPONSIBILITY IS ASSUMED FOR unchecked articles left in stations or cars.

STATIONS where no time is given trains do not stop.
