Note 3. Cars 0137/0237 and 0138/0238 operate Tri-Weekly, from Boston on Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday; from Atlanta or New Orleans on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

Note 4. Cars 0139/0239 and 0153/0253 operate four days each week, departing Boston on Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, Sunday; and departing Birmingham on Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, Sunday.

Note 5. Cars 0150/0250 operate Tri-Weekly, departing Boston on Monday, Wednesday, Saturday; and departing Los Angeles on Tuesday, Friday, Sunday.
