**GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Toronto, Hamilton and Buffalo Ry., operating through one of the most beautiful sections of Southern Ontario, is the connecting link between two great systems—the New York Central and the Canadian Pacific Railway. Through trains are operated from the Union Station, Toronto, to Central Terminal, Buffalo. The Union Station, Toronto is used jointly by the C.P.R. and C.N.R. and the N.Y.C. Central Terminal jointly by the N.Y.C. and Penna RR., so that passengers may reach many destinations without transfer to another station. At Buffalo, the other railway stations are easily accessible from N.Y.C. Terrace Station.

The tables shown in this timetable give the times at which trains may be expected to arrive at, and depart from the stations named. We cannot, however, guarantee their arrival and departure at the times stated, nor can we assume responsibility for delays, or consequences arising from delays. We do our best to maintain the published schedules.

Time from midnight to noon throughout the timetable is shown in light face type (A.M.) and from noon to midnight is shown in bold face type (P.M.)

**Tickets**—Whenever possible, buy your ticket before boarding trains.

Railway companies are not responsible for lost tickets, nor do they assume any liability for their loss. If you lose your ticket, buy another one. When you buy the second ticket, be sure to obtain a receipt. Report your loss to the conductor, or any railroad representative, and when you arrive at your destination, send the receipt for second ticket, along with an explanatory note, to the General Passenger Agent of the railroad from which lost ticket was purchased, and he will handle for proper adjustment. Write name and permanent address distinctly.

**Redemption of Tickets**—Tickets unused or partly used will be redeemed under tariff regulations at proper value. Send to J. K. Weston, General Passenger Agent, Hamilton, Ont., or turn in to any railroad agent.

**Children**—Under 5 years of age carried free, when accompanied by parent or guardian; 5 years of age and under 12, one half fare; 12 years of age and over, adult fare.

**Baggage**—Consists of wearing apparel, toilet articles and similar effects necessary for the comfort and convenience of the passenger on the journey, and must be enclosed in proper receptacles, such as trunks, valises, etc.

No single piece of baggage or other article weighing more than 250 pounds will be accepted for transportation in regular baggage service.

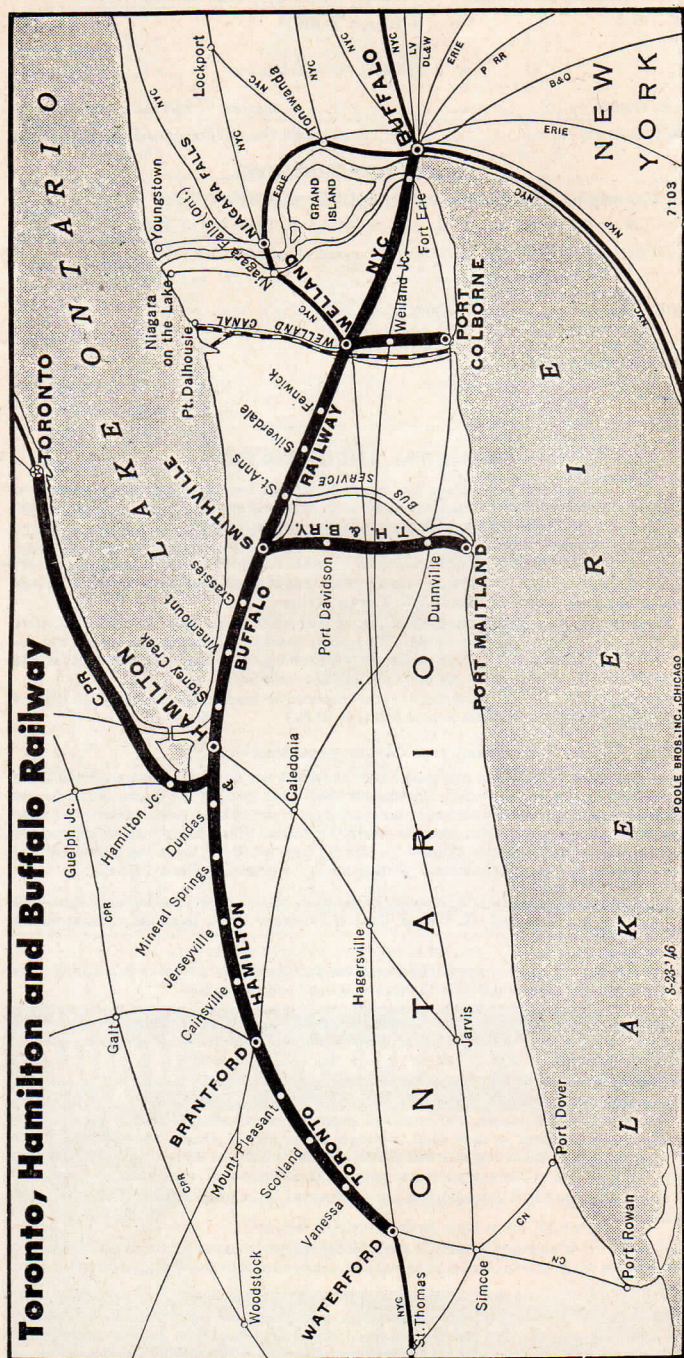
Unless otherwise stipulated, 150 pounds of baggage, not exceeding \$100.00 in value, will be checked without charge on each adult passenger ticket, and 75 pounds, not exceeding \$50.00 in value for a child travelling on a half ticket. A small additional charge is made for baggage over these weights. Have your name and permanent address on all luggage and packages.

Dogs and other small domestic pets are transported in baggage service, subject to tariff regulations.

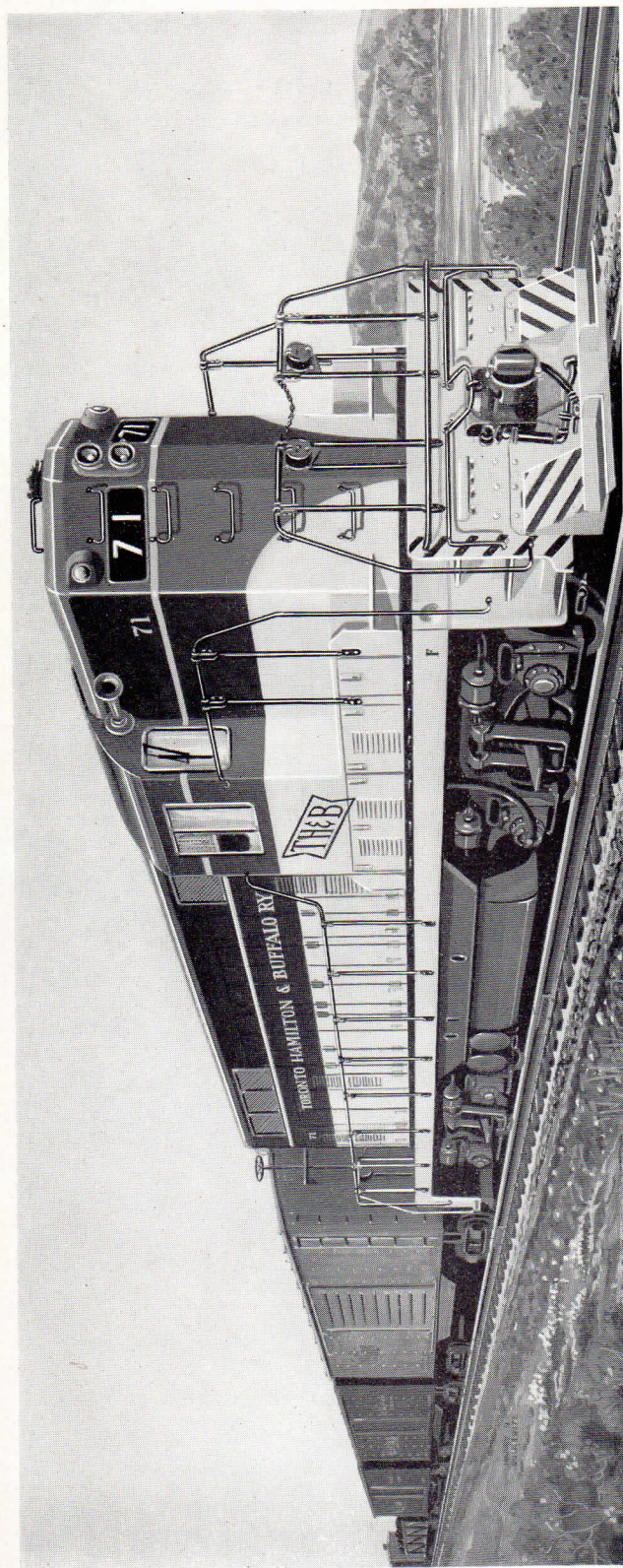
**CAUTION**—It is unlawful to carry in checked baggage or in passenger coaches anything of a combustible or explosive nature, such as matches, gunpowder, nitroglycerine, dynamite, celluloid, moving picture films.
