GENERAL INFORMATION

Responsibility-The Norfolk and Western Ry. Schedules, consists and designations of trains are subject to change without notice.

Time-Standard Times are shown throughout this timetable. (E. S. T.) denotes Eastern Standard Time, (C. S. T.) Central Standard Time, (M. S. T.) Mountain Standard Time and (P. S. T.) Pacific Standard Time.

From 12:01 A. M. to 12:00 o'clock noon, inclusive, is shown in lightface type, between 12:01 P. M. and 12:00 o'clock midnight by dark-face type.

Children's Fares-Children under five years of age may ride without charge when accompanied by a parent or guardian. However, one half-fare ticket is required when one, two or three children under five have exclusive use of a berth or parlor car seat. Children five years of age and under twelve, are charged a half-fare; children 12 years and older,

Purchase in Advance—Tickets for reserved Sleeping or Parlor car space and Coach seats should be purchased as far in advance as possible.
