All trains stop on flag at Shops, Tudor, Pantops, Glenrose, Foch, Hillby, Silver Hill, Belair, Kennerwood, Larkin, Ingersoll, Rock Creek, Rattlers Run, Bound Brook, Clifton, Konah, Dan, Robinson, Elmer, Coberly, Horn, Pottery, Cove, Ayer, Ferris, Country Club, Trestle Creek, Barnes, Lynn, Harpole. Nos. 62 and 63 only stop on flag at Sand St.

All trains entering or leaving Spokane will follow Main avenue and stop only at the near crossing of the following streets to receive or discharge passengers: Post, Howard, Washington, Division and Hamilton. All trains on Coeur d'Alene Division stop at Hamilton, Crestline and Nelson streets on flag to receive or discharge passengers. The Company reserves the right to vary from the above schedules.

VERA-OPPORTUNITY LINE

Cars leave the Terminal Building at 6:05 a. m., daily except Sundays, and every hour thereafter until 11:05 a. m., then 12:20 p. m., then every hour thereafter until 7:20 p. m., then 9:20 and 11:20 p. m. Leave Flora, westbound 5:57 a. m. daily, except Sundays, 6:57 a. m. 7:57 a. m. then 9:05, 10:05, 11:05, then 12:20 p. m. and every hour thereafter until 8:20, then 10:20 p. m. Sundays first car leaves the Terminal Building 7:05 a. m. Westbound, leave Flora 6:57 a. m.

FAST FREIGHT SERVICE

Full carload and less carload freight is dispatched daily except Sunday from Freight Terminal, Market and Ferry, Spokane, for all points on Coeur d'Alene, Liberty Lake, Hayden Lake Divisions and the Vera-Opportunity Line, for Harrison, St. Maries, St. Joe and Coeur d'Alene River Points. For all points on the Inland Division, including Freeman, Waverly, Rosalia, Oakesdale, Garfield, Palouse, Colfax, Moscow and for all points on W., I. & M. Ry., including Potlatch, Deary and Bovill.
