ADDITIONAL STOPS ON SIGNAL: Trains Barber on Stirling City branch line in Chico yard.

All trains obtained Clearance Card Form 2643 at Chico and Stirling City while operator on duty.

Derails at west end of Crouch and Paradise Sidings and on Logging Spurs.

Mixed trains will not exceed 15 miles per hour and passenger trains 18 miles per hour between Mile Post 6 and Stirling City; except that between Doon and Mile Post 22, westward mixed trains must not exceed 12 miles per hour.

Westward mixed trains stop 5 minutes at Doon, 10 minutes at Paradise and Crouch for inspection and cooling wheels. Passenger trains stop at Paradise 5 minutes to cool wheels. Retainers will be used on westward trains Stirling City to Butte Creek.

Tonnage of trains between Stirling City and Butte Creek must not exceed 80 MS per operative brake.
