 Standard time for the Houston Division will be shown by clock in Dispatchers office at San Antonio and Houston.
 East-bound freight trains will take siding at Richmond, Weimar, Ivy and Ilka for west-bound freight trains, entering siding from west end. The speed of all trains in the city limits of Houston, Richmond, Columbus, Waelder, Luling and San Antonio, must not exceed SIX miles per hour. Stella and Harrisburg are Terminal-stations for Harrisburg branch trains. Gonzales and Harwood are Terminal-stations for Gonzales branch trains. Glidden, Smith Junction and LaGrange are Terminal-stations for La-Grange branch trains.
 San Antonio, Glidden and Houston, are Terminal-stations for all main line trains.
 All trains will reduce speed to 6 miles per hour over tram-way crossing at Sugarland.

Day Telegraph offices will be open April 1 to October 31, from 7:00 a. m. until 7:00 p. m. November 1 to March 31, from 7:30 a. m. until 6:30 p. m.
 All Second, Third and Fourth Class trains must get Clearance Cards at Rosenberg if there are no telegraph orders for them.
 Trains Nos. 109, 110, 111 and 112 have absolute right of track against all other Third Class trains between Smith Junction and Glidden.
 Train No. 115 will run Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.
 Train No. 116 will run Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.
 East bound trains will come to a full stop before passing the semaphore at the west end of Houston yard, and will not proceed until the signal is changed from red to nothing by day and from a red to a green light by night.
 Harlem and Cibolo Valley Post Office are flag stations for Nos. 19 and 18; Cibolo Valley Post Office is flag station for Nos. 17 and 20.
 Glidden Yard Limits: From mile board west of Glidden to east end of Colorado River Bridge.
 No. 23 will pick up live stock at Harwood.
