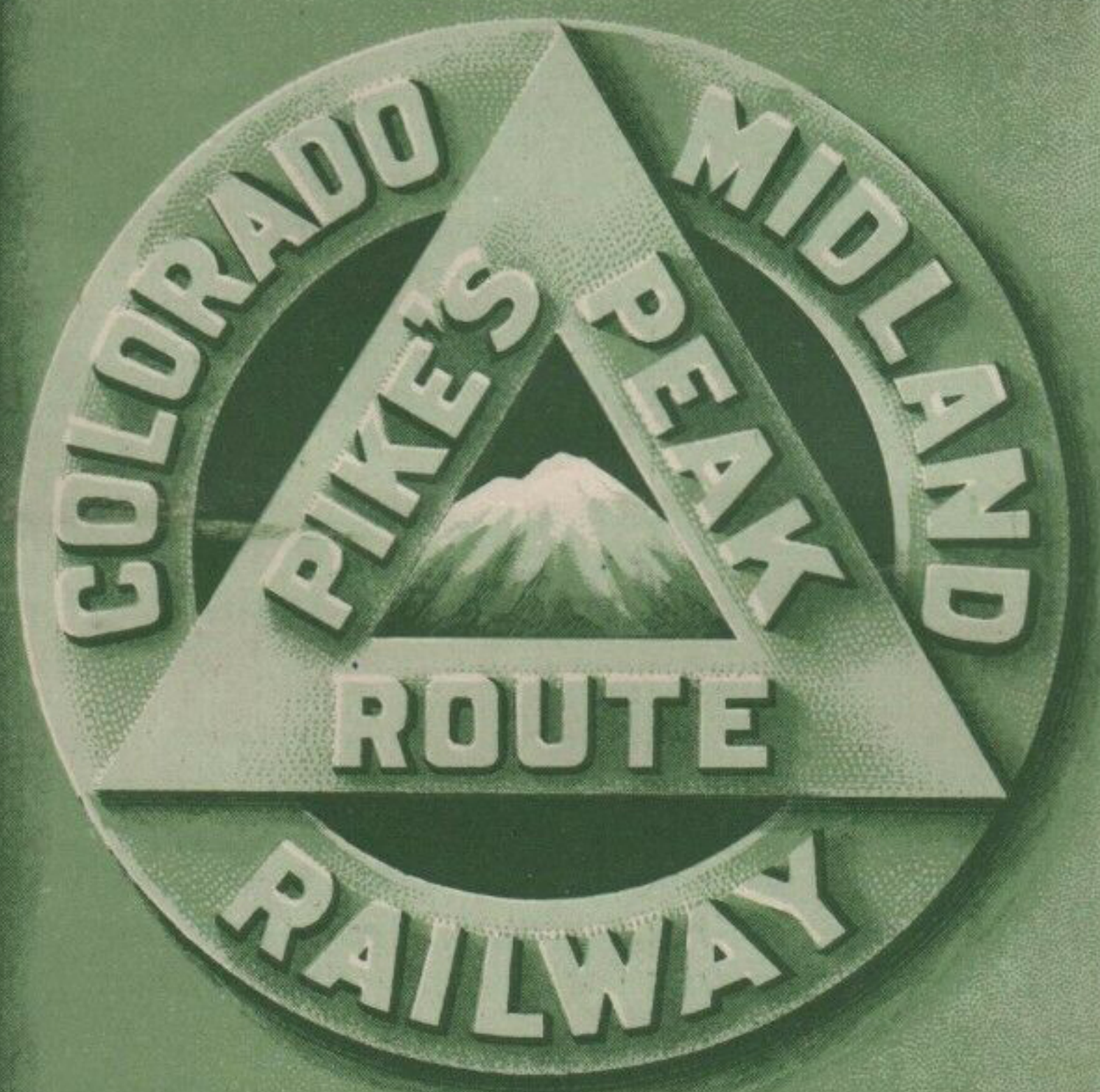


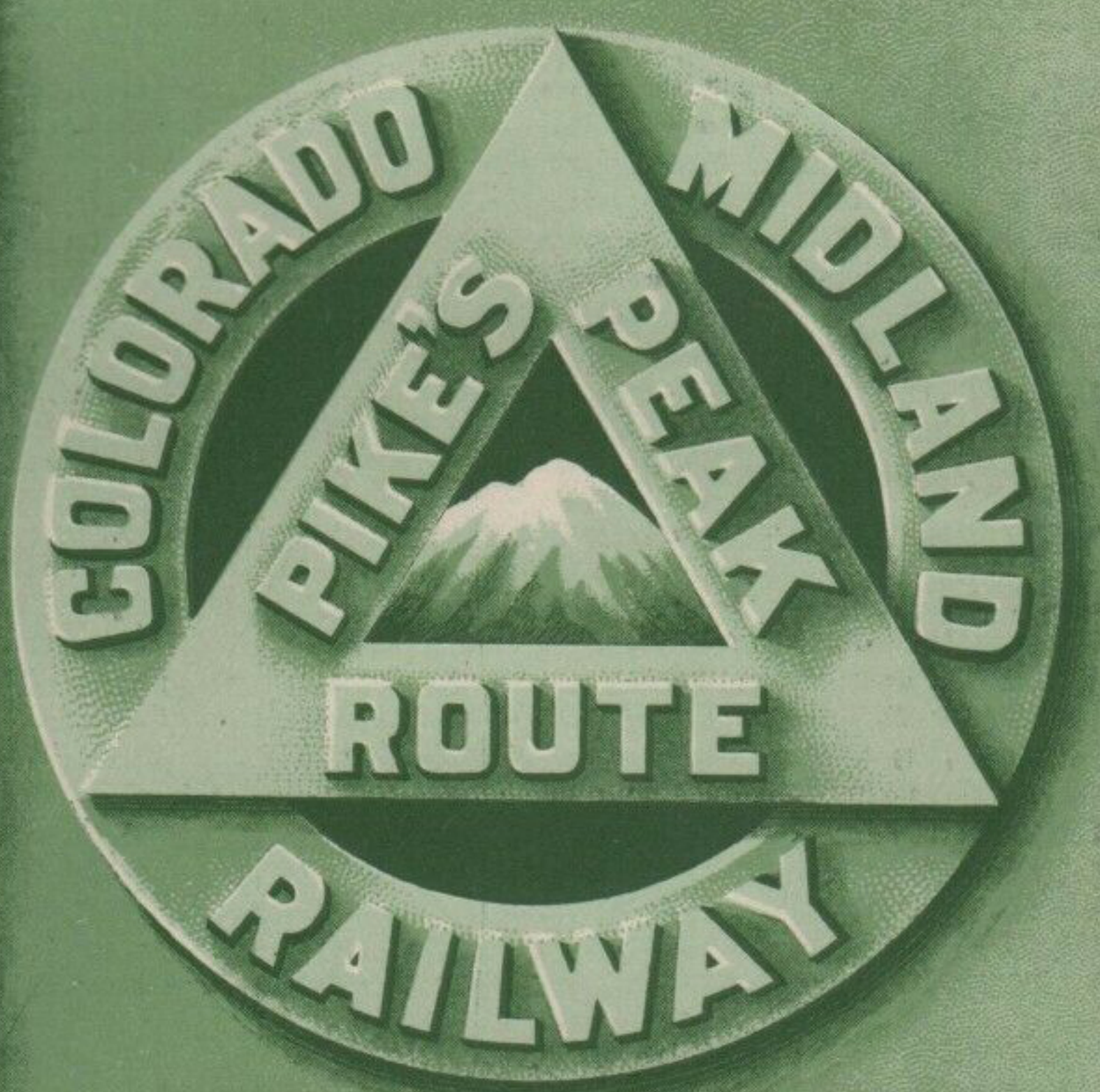

STOP-OVER PRIVILEGES

Stop-over privileges will be allowed at all points on the Colorado Midland Railway on passes and on all through tickets, the limit of which will permit, regardless of the conditions of the ticket, whether stamped "Continuous Passage," "No Stop-overs Allowed," etc., or not, provided there is a final limit on one way ticket or a transit limit on round-trip tickets of sufficient length to enable the passenger to make the stop-over desired, resume the journey and reach destination within said final or transit limit. On condition however that the passenger assumes all risk of ticket expiring in his hands, beyond our own line.

[a] The through tickets referred to above, to be tickets between Colorado common points and Utah common points and beyond, or through tickets originating at points outside the state of Colorado and destined to local points on our lines, and vice versa, but not tickets from points within the state of Colorado, destined to points in Colorado.

[b] On tickets between points in the state of Colorado the conditions of the contract and endorsements on same will govern stop-over privileges.

[c] Stop-overs will not be granted on local tickets when presented in connection with a Clergy special rate permit.

While care is taken to correctly publish the time of connecting lines, such figures are not guaranteed and no responsibility is assumed for errors.
