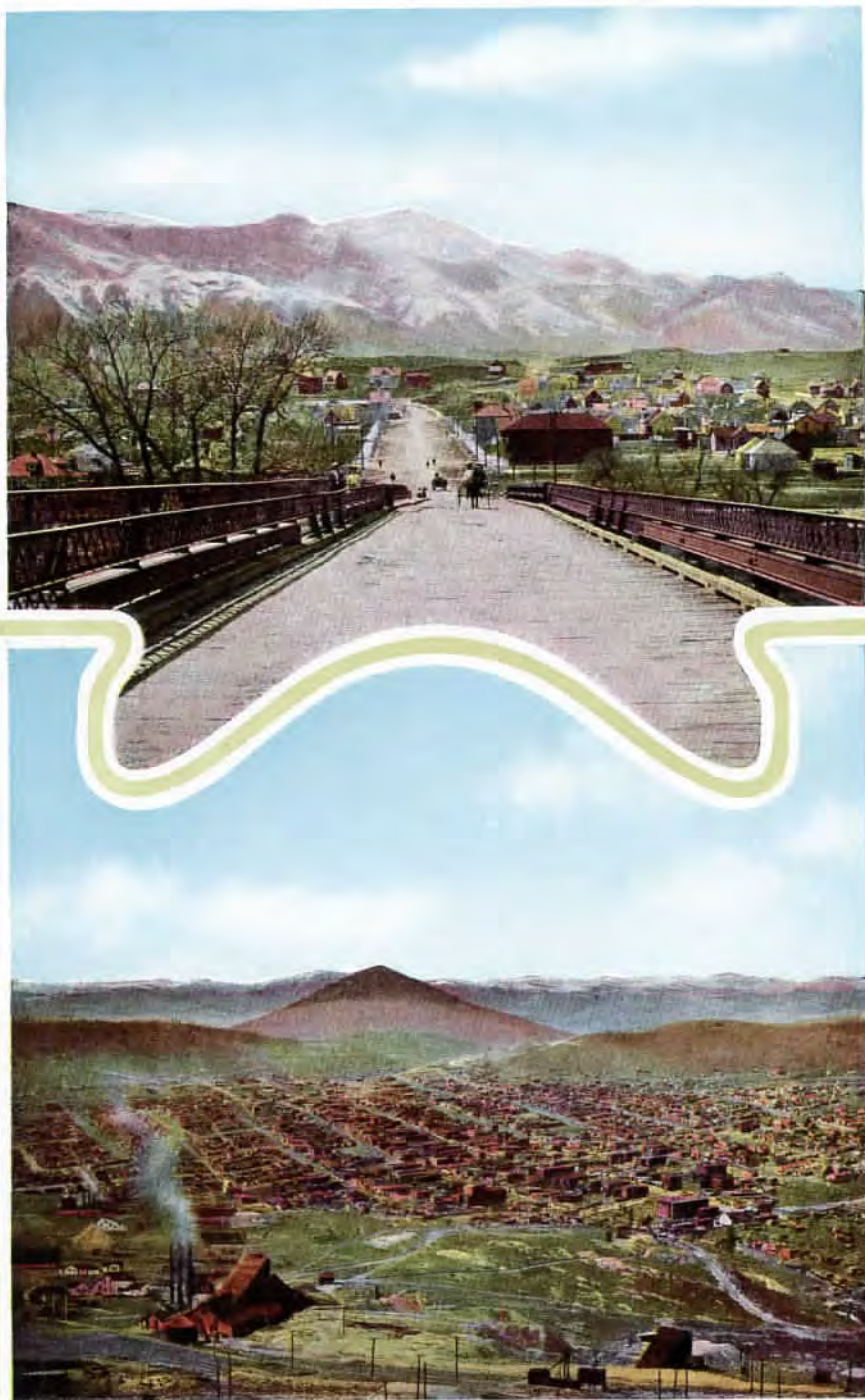
Salutation

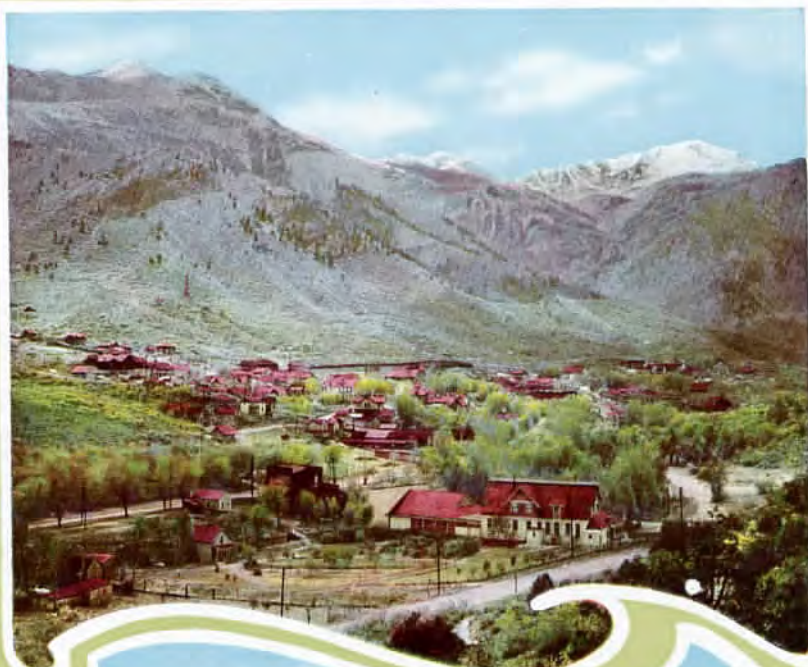

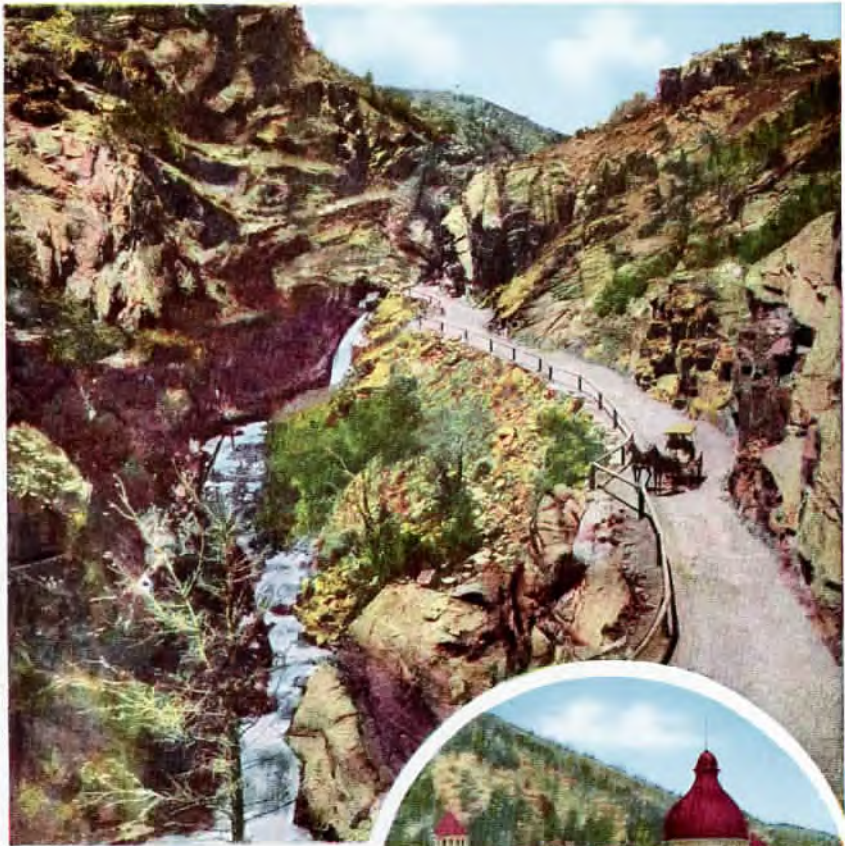


Upper Panel—Pike's Peak from Colorado Springs

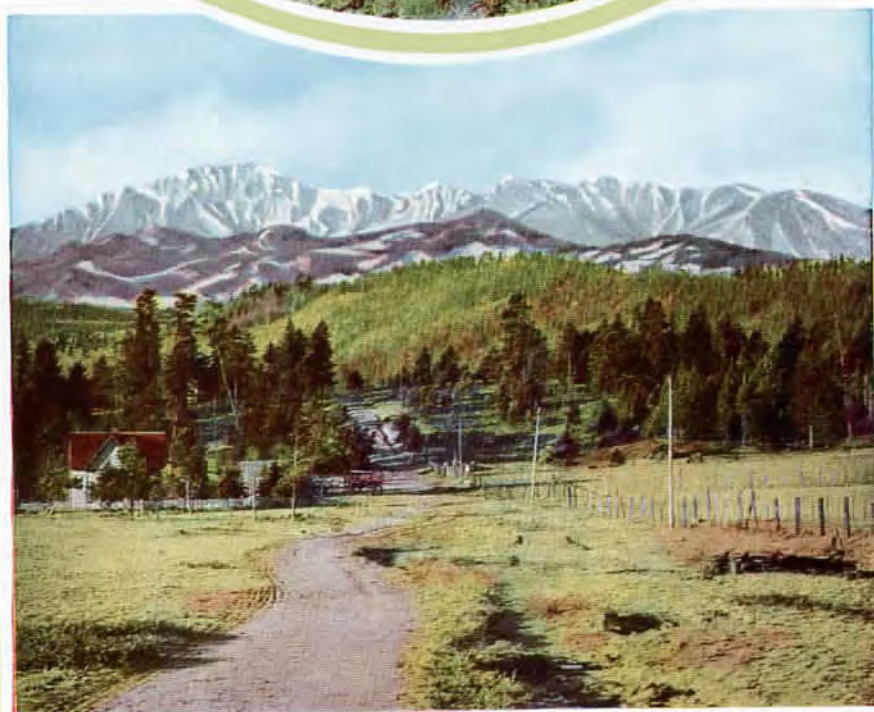
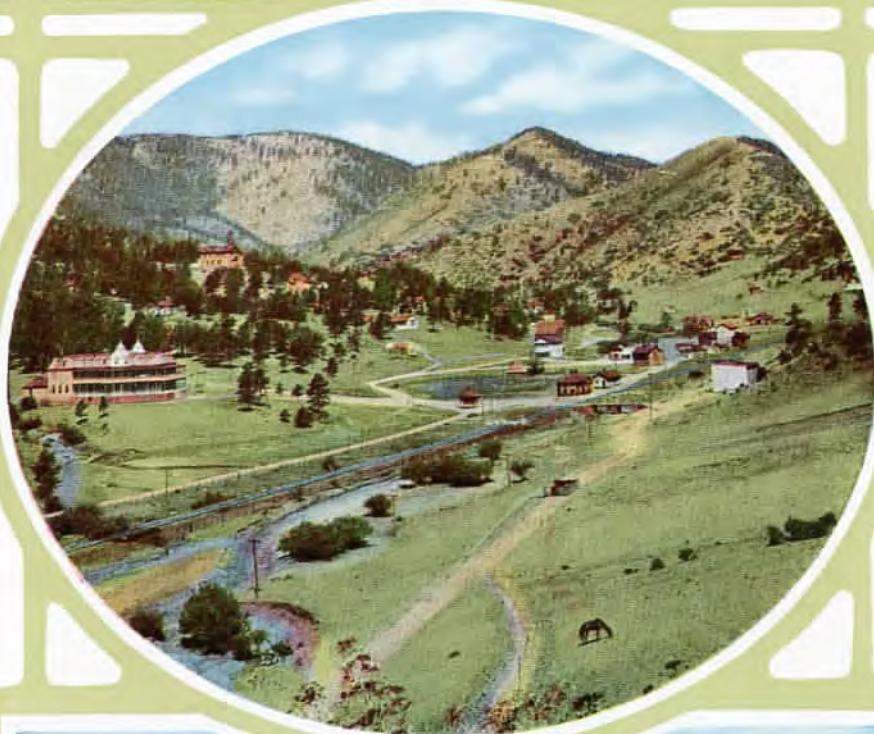


Upper Panel—Manitou and Pike's Peak

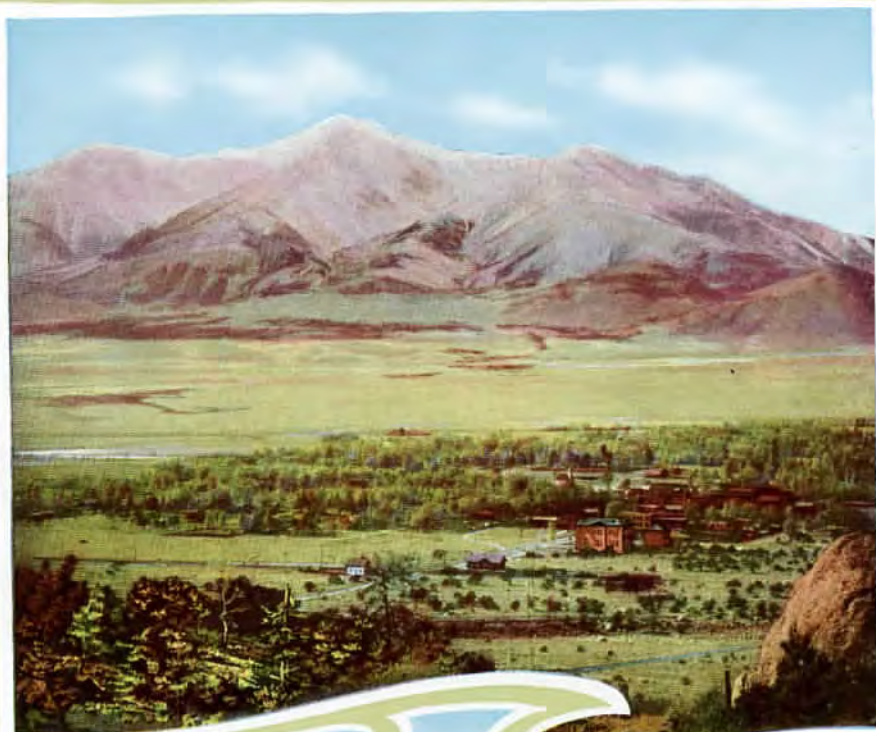


Upper Panel—Green Mountain Falls

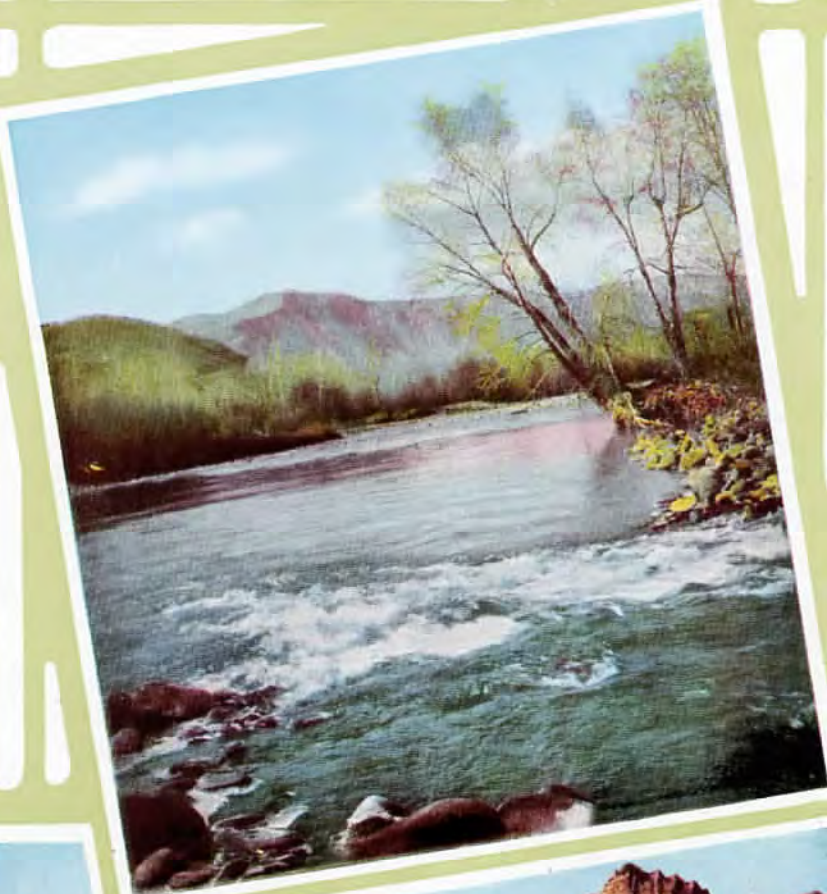


BEAUTIFUL GLENWOOD SPRINGS
Showing Hotel Colorado, the Famous Natural Hot Water Swimming Pool and a General View of the Town. Stream Spanned by Bridges is the Grand River.

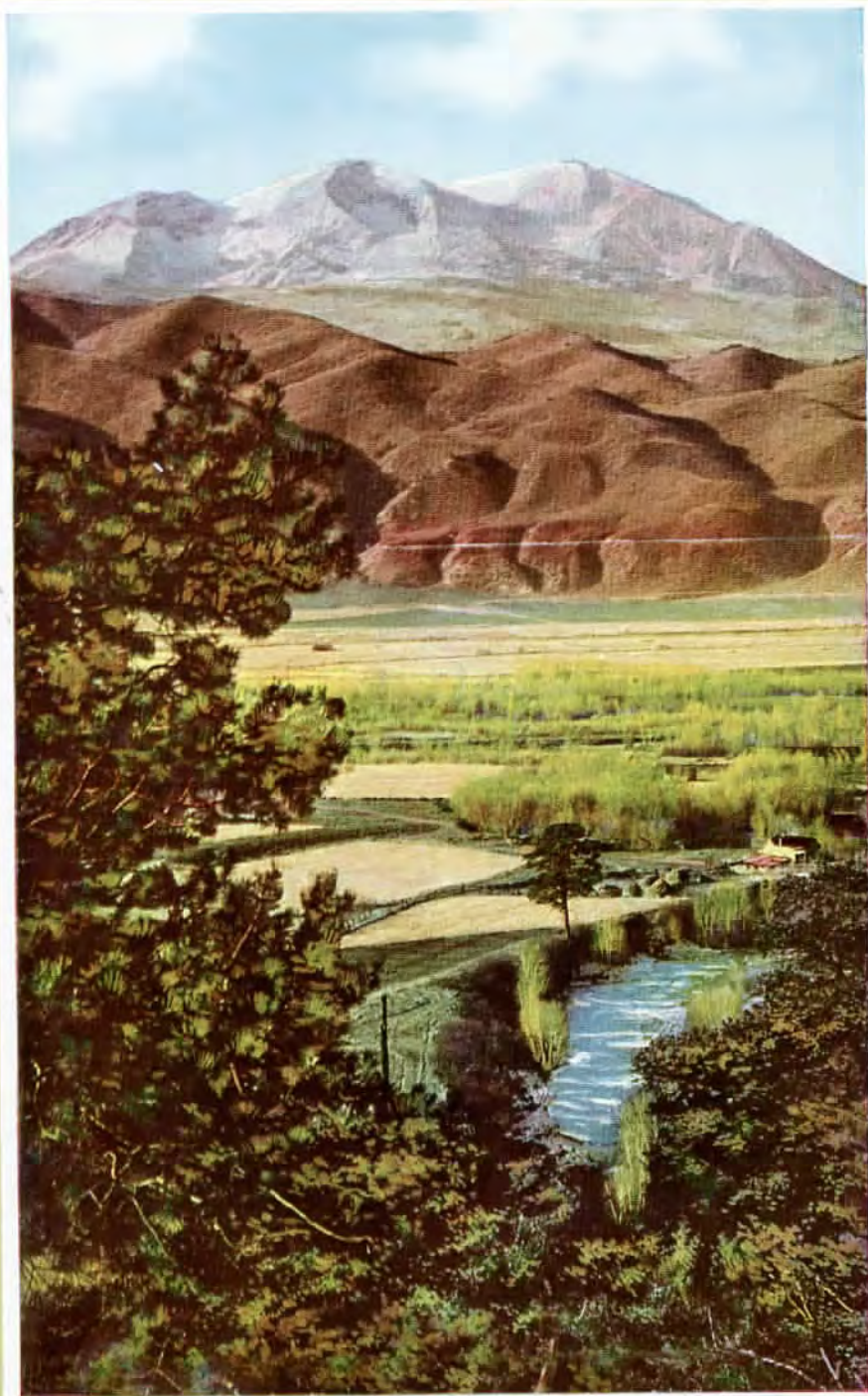


Upper Panel—City of Aspen, World's Greatest Silver Camp

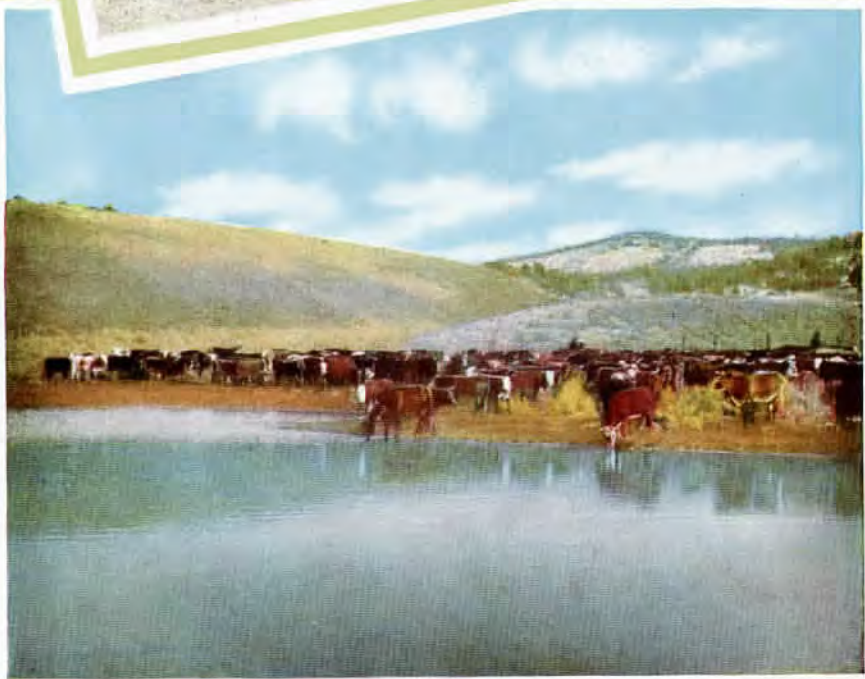

Train Service



Thru passenger service both ways between Denver and Ogden, via Salt Lake City, with thru Pullman observation sleeper on daylight trains 4 and 5. Thru trains carry dining cars for all meals, service a la carte. Direct connections with other roads are made by all eastbound and westbound trains at Denver, Colorado Springs, Salt Lake City and Ogden.
