

Bus / Rail / Air Connections

SAN FRANCISCO. The San Francisco Municipal Railway operates buses throughout San Francisco, including 11 routes serving the CalTrain station at Fourth and Townsend streets. Three commuter shuttles (Routes 80X, 81X, 82X) link rail passengers with downtown. The bus schedule times listed below are subject to change and travel times are approximate. Please call Muni at 415-673-6864 or consult a Muni timetable booklet for specific information.

Morning Commute: Routes 80X and 81X meet all trains arriving between 6:16 and 8:59. Route 82X buses meet most trains between 6:16 and 8:48. Route 80X travel time to Embarcadero Center is 11 minutes; Route 81X to Kearny and Sutter is 7 minutes; and Route 82X to Levi Plaza (Battery and Filbert streets) is 13 minutes and to the Presidio is 28 minutes.

Afternoon Commute: Route 80X leaves Front and Clay streets at 4:04, 4:18, 4:29, 4:37, 4:39, 4:54, 4:57, 4:58, 5:01, 5:03, 5:05, 5:14, 5:19, 5:34, 5:39 and 5:58 for the 11-minute trip to the station. **Route 81X** leaves Third and Mission streets at 4:00, 4:18, 4:29, 4:34, 4:50, 4:53, 4:57, 5:01, 5:04 and 5:25 for the 16-minute trip to the station. **Route 82X** leaves Levi Plaza at 4:03, 4:22, 4:34, 4:55, 5:06, 5:32 and 5:55 for the 15-minute trip to the station. (Bus departs from the Presidio at 4:12, 4:41 and 5:32.)

SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT. Specific information may be obtained by calling BART (San Francisco) at 415-992-2278. From BART to CalTrain, get off at the Powell Street BART Station, east end, and walk to Fourth Street. Take Muni Route 30 or 45 on Fourth at Market Street for the eight-minute ride to the CalTrain station. From CalTrain to BART, board Muni Route 30 or 45 to Third and Market streets, then walk right on Market to the Montgomery BART Station.

SAN FRANCISCO TRANSBAY TERMINAL. SamTrans, AC Transit and Golden Gate Transit serve the Transbay Terminal. From the Transbay Terminal to CalTrain, take Muni Route 15 or 42 on First Street for the 5-8 minute ride. From CalTrain to the Transbay Terminal, take Muni Route 42 on Townsend Street at the station.

SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT. The SFO Millbrae CalTrain Shuttle operates between CalTrain and the airport. The shuttle meets nearly every train seven days a week at the Millbrae CalTrain Station. From Peninsula points, transfer to SamTrans Routes 7B or 7F at the Broadway or Belmont CalTrain stations, respectively.

SAN JOSE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT. Transportation Agency Route 65 buses operate between the airport and the Santa Clara CalTrain Station.

AMTRAK INTERCITY TRAINS. At the San Francisco CalTrain Station, Amtrak buses serve passengers connecting with intercity trains in Emeryville or Oakland. At San Jose, CalTrain meets most of the daily Capitol Corridor trains or buses to and from Sacramento. CalTrain Trains 26, 28 and 130 connect with the Coast Starlight to Los Angeles, scheduled to depart at 8:30 a.m. Trains 79, 179 and 279 connect with the Coast Starlight from Los Angeles, scheduled to arrive at 7:25 p.m. Times are subject to change. Please call Amtrak at 1-800-872-7245 for reservations and information.

Ticket Information

CalTrain sells a variety of tickets. Tickets may be purchased in advance at staffed stations, through the mail or through ticket vending machines. A surcharge may apply when One-Way or Round-Trip tickets are purchased on board trains. Exact change (no pennies) or \$20 bills or smaller will be accepted when purchasing tickets on board trains. No checks accepted on board train. Please present ticket upon conductor's request.

MONTHLY TICKET. The Monthly Ticket is valid for unlimited rides between zones indicated on ticket. On Saturday, Sunday and holidays, the ticket is valid for unlimited rides between all zones served by CalTrain. Monthly Tickets go on sale at staffed stations on the 21st of the month or the next regular workday. Tickets will remain on sale until the 9th of the following month. An expired ticket will be honored for passage until noon on the first workday of the following month. Monthly Ticket holders wishing to travel past the zones indicated on their ticket may purchase a Zone Upgrade for 50¢ per zone upon first contact with the conductor or at a staffed station. A \$5 penalty will be charged for failing to buy the Zone Upgrade.

DISCOUNT MONTHLY TICKET. Discount Monthly Tickets are available to persons 17 years old and younger, qualified seniors or persons with disabilities. Also, high school students older than 17 with verifiable identification may purchase a Discount Monthly Ticket.

10-RIDE TICKET. The ticket is valid for **60 days** from date of purchase within zones indicated on ticket. It may be used by the purchaser and any member of travelling party.

ONE-WAY WEEKDAY DISCOUNT TICKET. A One-Way Weekday Discount Ticket is discounted 25 percent. It is valid on trains numbers 38, 40, 42, 44, 46, 48, 50, 49, 51, 53, 55, 57, 59 and 61 (see the area within the magenta-shaded box on the schedule). The ticket is **not** upgradable to full fare.

WEEKEND PASS. Valid from 5 a.m. Saturday through the last train on Sunday for weekend indicated on ticket. In addition to Memorial and Labor days, if any of the following holidays fall on a Friday or Monday, the Weekend Pass also will be valid on that day: New Year's Day, Independence Day and Christmas Day. The \$8 pass may be purchased at staffed stations at any time and on board trains on weekends.

PENINSULA PASS. CalTrain Monthly Ticket holders can purchase a Peninsula Pass at all CalTrain ticket offices. The pass **isn't** available with the 10-Ride Ticket. The Peninsula Pass provides unlimited rides on all Muni local buses and express Routes 80X, 81X and 82X. It's also good as a local fare credit on all Transportation Agency buses and light rail vehicles, and may be used as a 75¢ credit on the

Dumbarton Express route. SamTrans honors CalTrain Monthly Tickets as a local fare credit on all of its local and express buses. Monthly Ticket buyers traveling at least two zones exclusively within Santa Clara County may receive a free Peninsula Pass. Peninsula Passes **are** available with the purchase of Discount Monthly Tickets.

MUNI FAST PASS ON BOARD CALTRAIN. The Adult Muni Fast Pass, which is available throughout San Francisco, is honored for unlimited travel aboard CalTrain exclusively within San Francisco (Zone SF).

DISABLED PATRONS AND SENIOR CITIZENS. Disabled patrons and patrons aged 65 or older who present a Regional Transit Connection Discount Card, Medicare Card or Department of Motor Vehicle Disabled Placard Identification card may ride at approximately half the regular fare of a One-Way Ticket. An attendant accompanying a disabled patron also is eligible for this discount when indicated on the RTC Discount Card. Conductor may ask to see the RTC Discount Card to verify age or disability. RTC Discount Card applications are available at local transit agencies.

Bicycle Information

Each train can accommodate a maximum of 12 bicycles. Bicycles must be stowed in the designated bicycle storage space. Yellow decals on the outside of the cards indicate which cars have bicycle racks.

For information on renting a bicycle locker, located at many stations, call CalTrain at 415-508-6350. For information regarding lockers at stations south of the Tamien station, call 408-321-7520.

Collapsible bicycles are not to be placed in the designated bicycle storage areas.

Wheelchair Accessibility

At designated stations (*see map on reverse side*), wheelchair users board **the second car from the north**, marked with the blue international disabled symbol. The platform boarding position will be marked with the same symbol. Each train can accommodate only two wheelchairs.
