RAISED RAILROAD RATES

Out of every dollar earned by the Southern Pacific, the stockholders received in 1919 in dividends forty per cent less than in 1914.

Where does the money go?

The revenue from increased freight rates does not go to the stockholders; it goes to meet increased wages, higher cost of materials, greater taxes and interest on money borrowed to create

More Railway Facilities

Good Railway Service is vital to the welfare of our country's business. Such service can be assured only by railroad rates bringing sufficient revenues to pay men wages that will keep them wholeheartedly on the job and give investors a return that will make them willing to put their dollars into the railroads; and in running a railroad not only must labor be paid but almost as much more money must be used for supplies of all kinds, including the replacement of worn-out materials, and the purchase of fuel.

The recent increase in railroad freight rates and fares has been carefully calculated by the Interstate Commerce Commission, following the instructions given in the National Railway Transportation Act of 1920, to the end that these needs may be met and good railway service assured. Only a six per cent return upon the value of the railway properties of the country as determined by the Interstate Commerce Commission is provided for in these rates. The rest goes to taxes and operating expenses and out of the six per cent at least one-half of one per cent must be put back into the railroads to increase their facilities.

Please keep this in mind when paying the increased railroad rates and that unless you did make such increased payments good service could not be created or maintained.

The stockholders' share in the total railway revenue is small. In 1919 for every dollar the Southern Pacific Company paid its stockholders in dividends, 73 cents was paid in taxes, while in 1911 for every dollar paid the stockholders in dividends only 33 cents was paid in taxes. Its tax bill in 1914, \$5,461,568; in 1919, \$12,842,270.

The Southern Pacific Company stockholders received in 1919 40% less of the revenues of the company in dividends than they received from its revenues in 1914.

The increased cost in wages and materials in 1919 of the Southern Pacific Company compared with the previous year amounted to \$18,833,500, or a total of \$1,500,000 more than the stockholders received in 1919 altogether.

The recent increases in wages allowed by the National Railway Labor Board will just about equal on the lines of the Southern Pacific Company the dividends received by the stockholders this year.

The vital need of the country is for more cars, more locomotives, more tracks, which can be secured only as the railroads can secure more money to provide them with. Only increased rates make it possible for the railroads to borrow such money in competition with other forms of investment.

The problem is not one of what the stockholders get, which is after all a relatively small part of the earnings of the railroads, but what the public is going to get in the way of efficient service necessary to the prosperity of all, and there is just one way of getting and maintaining efficient service—to pay for it reasonably as you would for any other essential need.

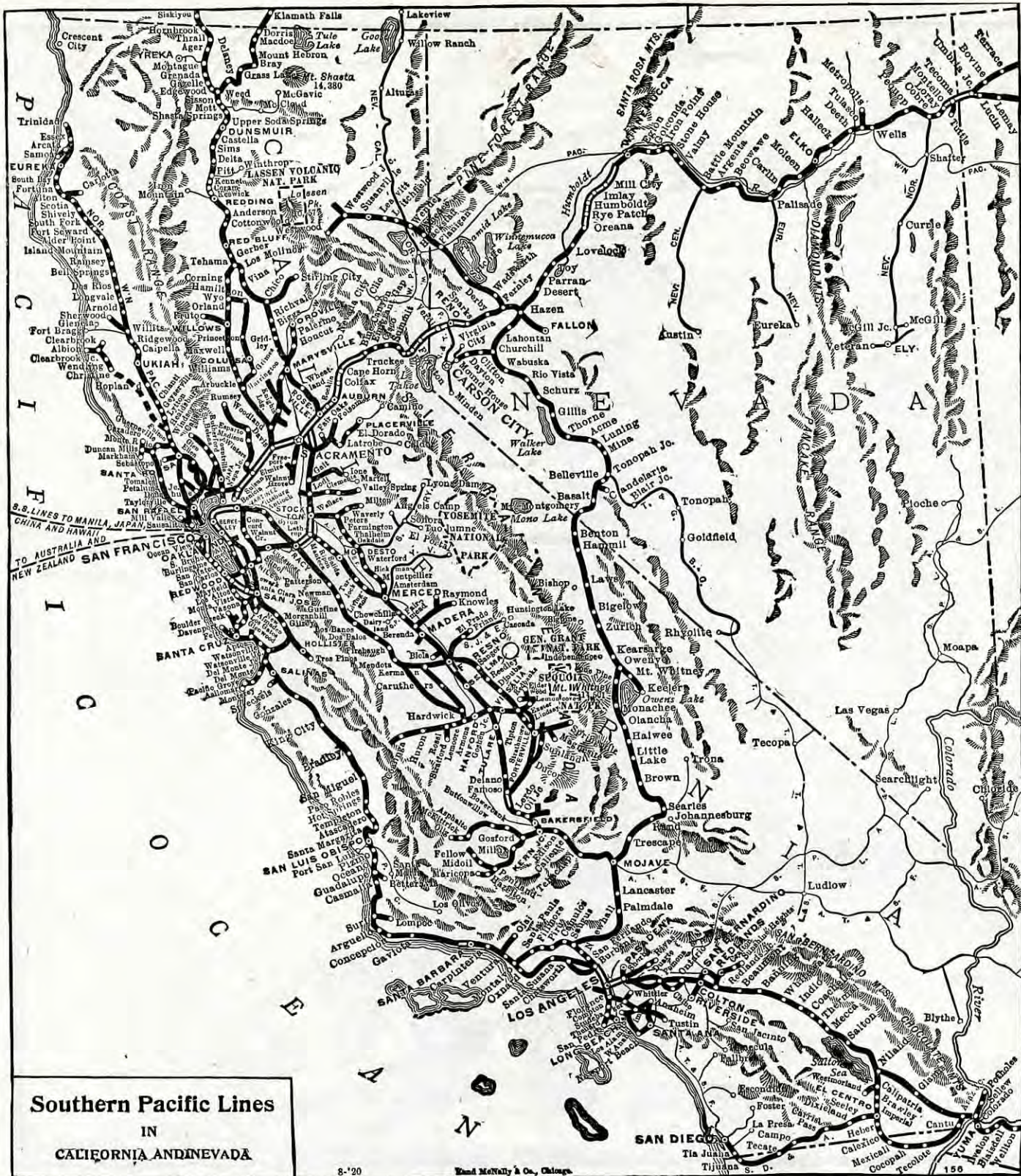

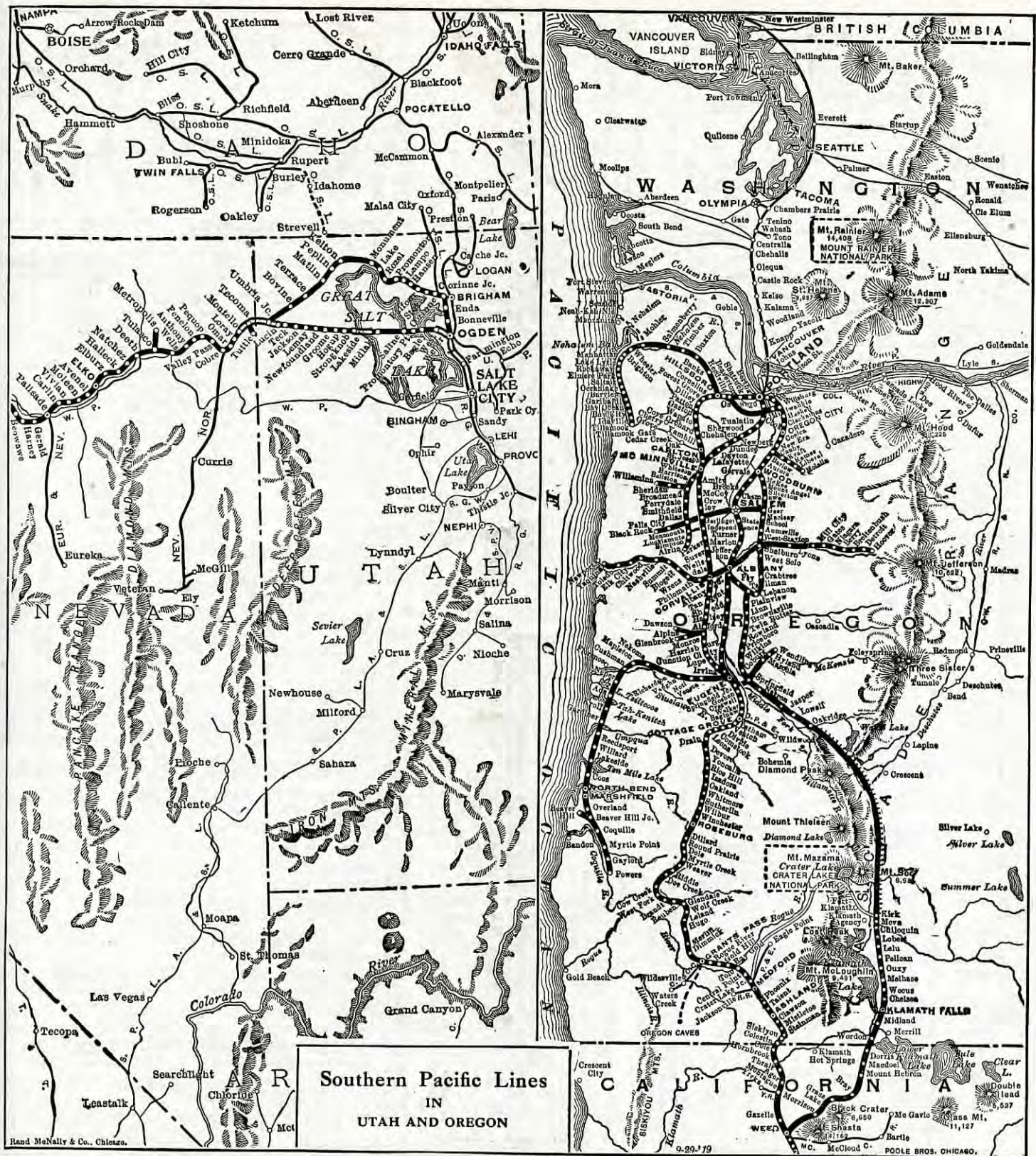
