SUNDAY, JULY 8, 1923

New time table will be put into effect improving the service to our patrons using commuter trains. Two new midday trains will also be added between San Francisco and Mayfield leaving San Francisco at 10 AM and 2:10 PM, returning from Mayfield at 12:38 PM, and 3:58 PM.

To comply with many requests the present 10 PM train from San Francisco will leave at 10:30 PM. This will accommodate those patrons desiring a longer evening in San Francisco and afford a convenient connection for passengers arriving at San Francisco, Ferry Station, at 10:05 PM from the San Joaquin Valley on our train No. 51 and from the Sacramento Valley on our train No. 209.

Train No. 46 now leaving 3d St. Station at 5:05 PM, will leave at 4:50 PM for Redwood City instead of San Jose. This train serves the industries near 23d St., 14th Avenue and South San Francisco. It has been put ahead so that trains following at 5:03, 5:15, and 5:20 PM may make their schedule and not be held back by No. 46 as they are today.

Westbound trains have been changed somewhat to meet desire of patrons for particular arrival time at San Francisco.

These improvements represent quite an addition to our operating expense and it is our sincere hope that this increased expense will be fully justified by the patronage that will be accorded the new trains.

From the following, which shows the cost per trip of riding between San Francisco and a few of the principal stations on the Peninsula on 10-ride and 30-ride commutation tickets, you will note that traveling on the Southern Pacific, with its advantages of safety and comfort, is comparatively cheap.

10-ride tickets are good for bearer; time limit two months.

30-ride tickets are good for any member of household; time limit six months.

Similar fares are in effect between San Francisco and other points on the Peninsula.
