ALL CONCERNED:

- 1. Effective 12:01 am Pacific Time, Monday, February 22, 1993, Willamette & Pacific Railroad Inc. (Reporting Marks WPRR) assumes exclusive operational control of the following former Southern Pacific branch lines: Albany yard and the Toledo Branch, West Side Branch (Monroe through east switch Derry, inclusive), Bailey Branch, and Dallas Branch. In addition, effective same date WPRR trains will have trackage rights on Southern Pacific Valley Line between Albany and Eugene Yard.
- 2. Effective 10:30 pm Pacific Time, Sunday, February 28, 1993, Willamette & Pacific Railroad Inc. (WPRR) assumes exclusive operational control of the former Southern Pacific West Side Branch (east switch Derry through St. Joseph, inclusive), Willamina Branch, and that portion of the Newberg Branch between St. Joseph and MP 750 east of Newberg. Effective same date, WPRR trains will have trackage rights between Newberg and Brooklyn via Cook and Willsburg Jct. on the remainder of Southern Pacific's Newberg branch (MP 750 through Cook), the Tillamook Branch, and the Valley Line.
- 3. Willamette & Pacific Railroad Time Table No. 1 is in effect west of Derry at 12:01 am Monday, February 22, 1993, and is in effect east of Derry at 10:30 pm Sunday, February 28, 1993. Employees whose duties are affected thereby, shall obtain a copy and be governed thereby. Copies may be obtained at WPRR general office in the SP/Amtrak station at Albany.
- 4. Effective 12:01 am, Monday, February 22, 1993, the following operating rules have been adopted by WPRR:
- a. General Code of Operating Rules, Second Edition, dated October 29, 1989, as modified by WPRR Timetable and General Orders.
- b. Southern Pacific Lines Current Rules and Instructions Governing Air Brake System and Train Handling dated April 19, 1991, including those additions, deletions, and revisions contained in SP Pacific Region Timetable No. 1, System Special Instructions, Section "I" (pages 31-33).
- c. Southern Pacific Lines Safety and General Rules for all Employees, as originally issued April 15, 1991.
- d. Southern Pacific Hazardous Material Instructions as contained in Section "P" of Southern Pacific Pacific Region Timetable, System Special Instructions (pages 42 52).
