SPECIAL RULES and INSTRUCTIONS NEVADA NORTHERN RAILWAY

- 1. Nevada Northern Railway is governed by the General Code of Operating Rules 3rd edition dated April 10, 1994.
- 2. All trains and engines must move within yard limits under control so they may stop at any time and avoid accidents.
- **3.** All trains must obtain clearance card (Form 2643) before leaving their initial station.
- **4.** Enginemen will not depart East Ely until notified by Conductor that brake test has been completed.
- 5. Tunnel No. 1 will not clear a man on top or on side of car.
- 6. Engines must not exceed speed of five(5) miles per hour over switches between coal chute and engine house East Ely.
- 7. When cars are detached from engines, or set out any point on grade, they must be securely blocked in addition to hand brakes being set.
- **8.** When tying up, brakeman will accompany engine to roundhouse. Engineers will report any case where brakeman fails to turn engine into house.
- **9.** Mainline switch at Hiline will be kept lined for Mill Branch.
- 10. Northern Nevada Railroad Corporation employees must have a copy of current Nevada Northern Railway timetable when operating on joint trackage.
- 11. Train dispatching provided by Northern Nevada Railroad Corporation.
- 12. Employees in accepting operating duties assume its risks. Each employee is required so far as possible to be responsible not only for his own safety but the avoidance of injury to others.
- 13. The following symbols when placed in column on timetable page indicate:

O -Oil

P -Phone

Y -Turning facility
