### SAFETY FIRST SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Employees will refrain from loud talking and unnecessary noise in and around the Terminal Station.

The noisy handling of mail, baggage or express, the rough handling of cars or any other conditions that would disturb passengers is prohibited.

Conductor must see that toilet room doors in all passenger equipment are kept locked, except when sanitary receptacles are applied to cars in Union Terminal. Garbage or other refuse must not be thrown from dining or other cars.

When a train or engine is waiting to cross from one track to another and during the approach or passage of a train or engine on the tracks involved, all switches connected with the movement must be secured in the normal position. Before starting to make the movement all switches involved must be properly lined and not restored to normal until the movement is completed.

Hand operated switches equipped with electric locking mechanism will be handled only on authority of the Tower Director. After use, switches must be restored to normal position.

All accidents, injuries or damage to company property must be reported promptly in writing to the Manager by employes in charge at point of occurrence, with names and addresses of witnesses.
