DESCRIPTION OF ROAD

The Colorado-Kansas Railway Company owns and operates a standard gauge, single track railway located entirely in the county of Pueblo, state of Colorado, and extending from a connection with The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway at Pueblo, northwesterly to Stone City.

MILEAGE AND VALUATION SECTIONS

The entire property has been reported under one valuation section.

Its mileage is as follows:

CHARACTERISTICS OF COUNTRY

The country traversed is a rolling prairie. There is some farm development. The principal source of revenue is transportation of sand stone from quarries at Stone City.

ROAD

The grading is medium excepting the two miles in the vicinity of Stone City where it is heavy.

The ties are principally untreated pine.

The main line is laid with 70 lb. new Open Hearth rail.

On the first two miles from Pueblo the track is ballasted with a light surface of cinders. The remainder of the line is unballasted.

ENGINEERING AND GENERAL EXPENDITURES

Engineering has been computed at 4 per cent upon the Road Accounts Nos. 3 to 47 inclusive.

General Expenditures are computed at 1.5 per cent upon the Road Accounts Nos. 1 to 47 inclusive, except Account No. 2, Land.

Interest during construction has been computed at 6 per cent per annum for 9 months, or one half the construction period plus 3 months, upon the Road Accounts Nos. 1 to 47 inclusive, except Account No. 2, Land, and upon General Expenditures, except Account No. 76, and at 6 per cent per annum for 3 months upon Equipment Accounts Nos. 51 to 56 inclusive.

GENERAL INFORMATION

(a) Grading. Grading has been computed upon the two-way basis.

(b) Shrinkage. For shrinkage 10 per cent has been added to embankment and ballast quantities.

(c) Waste. The following percentages have been added:

Spikes	3 per cent for waste
Bolts	1 " " " "
Angle bars	2 " " " short rail

(d) Salvage.
