

Special Information FOR PASSENGERS

THIS COMPANY IS NOT RESPONSIBLE for errors in timetables, inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connection; schedules herein are subject to change without notice.

BUY TICKETS before boarding train at stations where tickets are sold.

CHILDREN under five years of age may travel free, when accompanied by parent or guardian; five years of age and under twelve, one-half fare; twelve years of age and over, full fare.

ADJUSTMENT OF FARES. In case of dispute with conductors or agents, pay fare required, take receipt and communicate with General Passenger Agent, Norfolk 10, Va.

REDEMPTION OF TICKETS. Tickets unused or partly used, will be redeemed under tariff regulation at proper value. Application for redemption should be made to General Passenger Agent, Norfolk 10, Va.

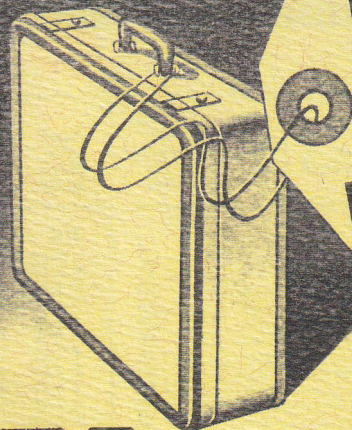
STOP-OVER at intermediate points should be requested when presenting ticket to conductor.

BAGGAGE SERVICE CHARGE, ETC. A service charge of twenty-five cents is made for checking each piece of hand baggage and fifty cents for each trunk. One-hundred and fifty pounds of baggage not exceeding \$100.00 in value may be checked without additional charge for each adult passenger, and seventy-five pounds not exceeding \$50.00 in value for each child traveling on a one-half fare ticket. Passengers have the privilege of declaring excess value on their baggage at a nominal charge of twenty cents for each additional \$100.00 or fraction thereof over that allowed on their ticket. Limit of valuation not to exceed \$2500.00.

BICYCLES (not motorcycles), BABY CARRIAGES, DOGS AND GUNS are transported in baggage car subject to tariff regulations.

LOST ARTICLES should be inquired for at office of General Passenger Agent, Terminal Building, Norfolk 10, Va.

NO RESPONSIBILITY IS ASSUMED for unchecked articles left in stations or cars.

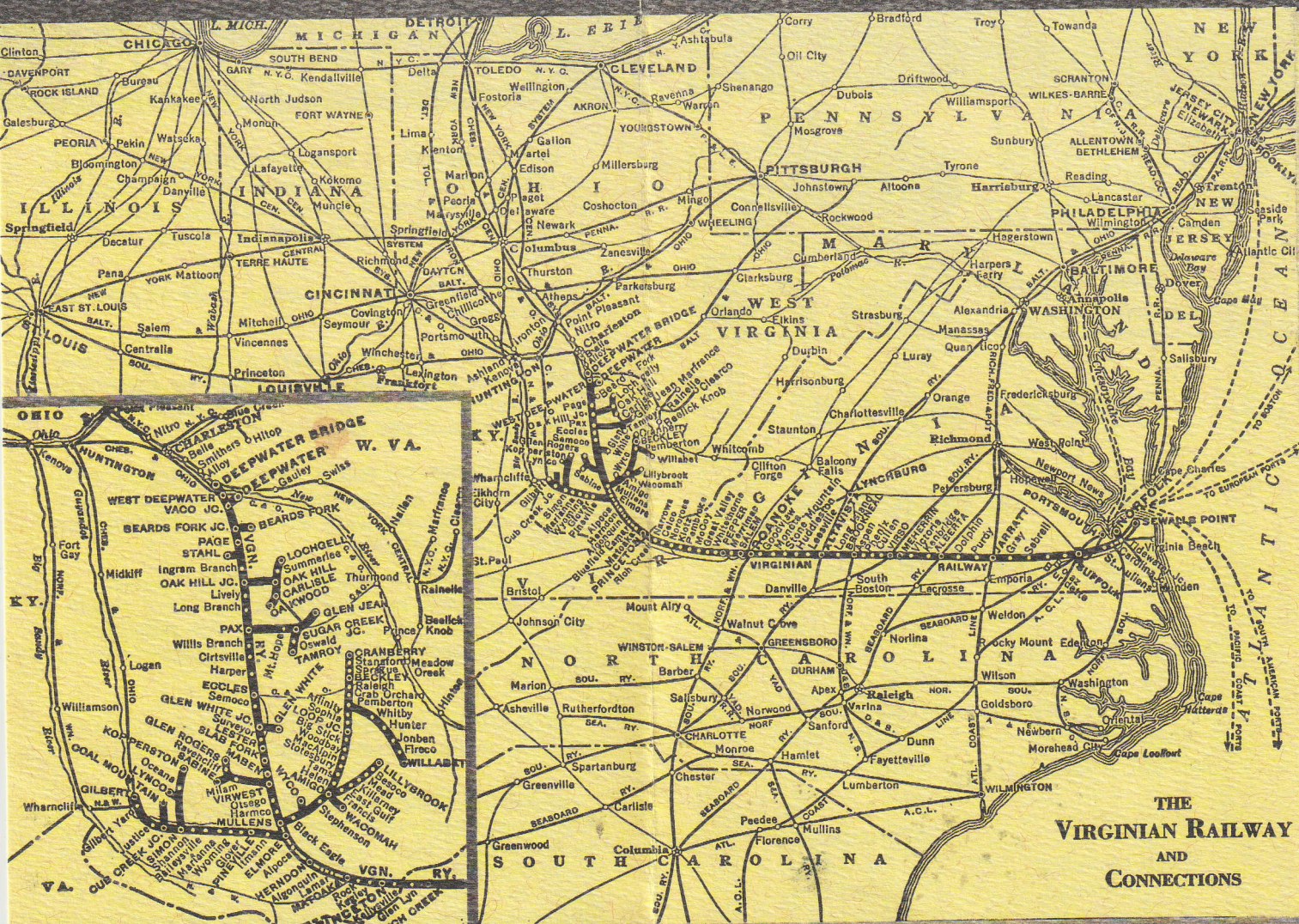
