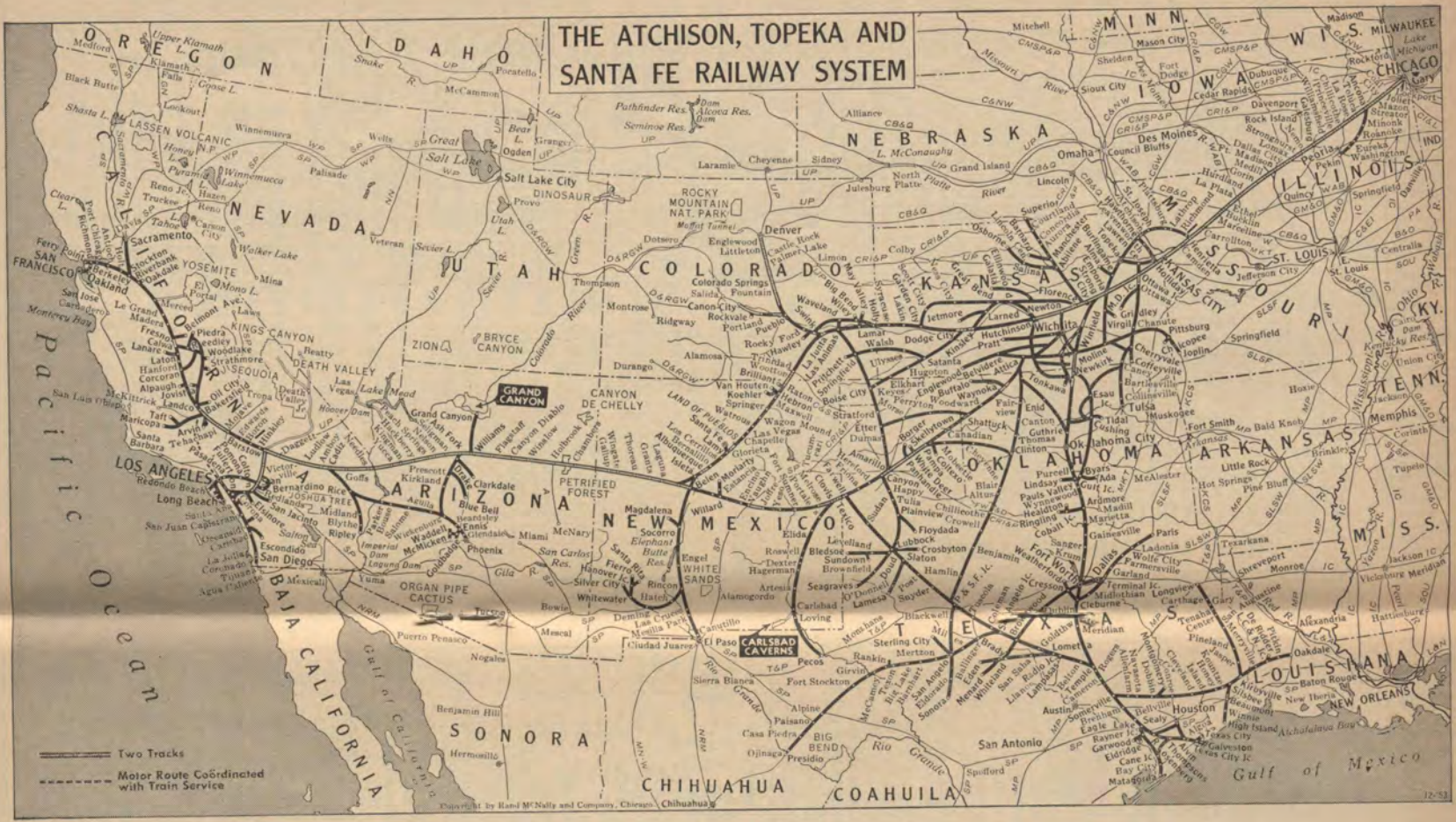




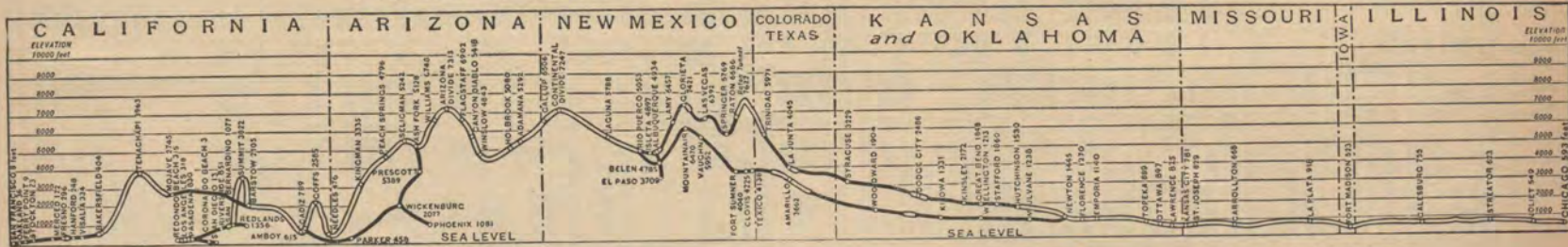

SPECIAL SERVICES for Santa Fe Patrons

**LONG BEACH.** Trainside motor coach connections are made with Santa Fe transcontinental trains (except Train 18 and Train 4) at Pasadena, and Fullerton, California, providing interstate passengers and their baggage with direct service to and from Long Beach at no extra charge.

**RAIL-AUTO SERVICE.** At certain cities, this convenient travel plan offers Santa Fe patrons the exclusive use of a new automobile at reasonable charge during their stay in those cities.

**TRANSFER SERVICE AT CHICAGO.** Passengers holding tickets through Chicago, including Parmelee Transfer Coupon, and having more than three hours between trains, may deliver their hand luggage to the Parmelee Desk at *incoming* depots at the cost of 15c parcel room charge for each piece, and receive claim check for claiming baggage at parcel room (24 hours storage) of *outgoing* depots. The Parmelee transfer coupon—included as part of your through ticket—also provides transfer in Parmelee Coaches from your incoming depot to outgoing depot, or any hotel or other destination in downtown Chicago.

**BAGGAGE INFORMATION.** 150 pounds of baggage, with \$100 valuation, checked free for each adult on valid transportation; 75 pounds and \$50 free valuation on each 1/2 fare. No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds, or single shipments exceeding \$2500 will be checked. Free valuation on cartons is \$25, limited to 50 pounds.

In connection with Family Plan sales one ticket is issued on which 300 pounds of baggage (not exceeding \$200 in value) will be checked free.

Intrastate in California limitations on free value allowance—trunk \$100, valise, suitcase or traveling bag \$50, and box, bundle or package \$10.
