Class A, F-7 and F-3 engines when operated on No. 102 or No. 103's schedule, or sections thereof, will be permitted to operate in accordance with that schedule, which provides for a maximum speed of 90 miles per hour, with restrictions now in effect for the trains referred to. Other classes of power operating on Nos. 102 and 103's schedule, or sections thereof, must have speed regulated as indicated: F-6, F-5 engines—75 miles per hour maximum speed, L-2, L-3 engines—50 miles per hour maximum speed, S-2 engines—70 miles per hour, maximum speed.
