General Information

The time of arrival and departure of trains given herein is subject to change without notice and is not guaranteed, nor does the Lake Shore Electric Railway Company assume responsibility for delays or other interruptions of service from sources beyond its control.

Purchase Tickets—Passengers are requested to purchase tickets before boarding trains to avoid payment of extra charge. In case of disagreement with conductors or agents, pay the amount charged, take a receipt, and communicate immediately with the General Passenger Agent.

Redemption of Tickets—Tickets unused, or partly used, will be redeemed under tariff regulations at proper value.

Interline Tickets—Interline tickets for nearly all
Ohio electric interurban points may be purchased
at any Lake Shore Electric Railway ticket office,
and baggage checked through to destination.

Baggage—Baggage will be handled to and from all principal Lake Shore Electric Railway stations under tariff regulations. Baggage not exceeding 150 pounds in weight will be checked free on one full fare ticket and 75 pounds on one-half fare ticket. The company does not guarantee to forward baggage on the same train on which the passenger travels, but will forward it at the earliest convenient opportunity.

Parcel Checking Facilities—Parcel rooms will be found at the principal Lake Shore Electric stations where packages, hand baggage, etc., may be checked and cared for at a charge of 10c per piece for each twenty-four hours or fraction thereof.

Lost Articles—Articles found on trains are immediately forwarded to the Lost and Found Department of the Lake Shore Electric Railway at Sandusky, Ohio.

Hand Baggage—Hand Baggage in cars must be restricted to that which can be conveniently carried, such as traveling bags, valises, telescopes, etc., or packages, boxes and bundles which are not too large or cumbersome.

Rates for Children—Children under five (5) years of age in charge of parent or competent guardian, carried free. Children over five years of age and under twelve are required to pay half-fare. Children twelve (12) years of age or over are required to pay full fare.


To Flag Trains—Local trains pick up passengers at all indicated stops if signalled. Signal should be given by extending the arm across the track. The motorman will answer with two short blasts of the whistle. At night light a match or use flashlight if possible. Or hold a lighted newspaper across the track so that it will be seen plainly by the motorman. As the car approaches step back from the track, to a safe distance.
