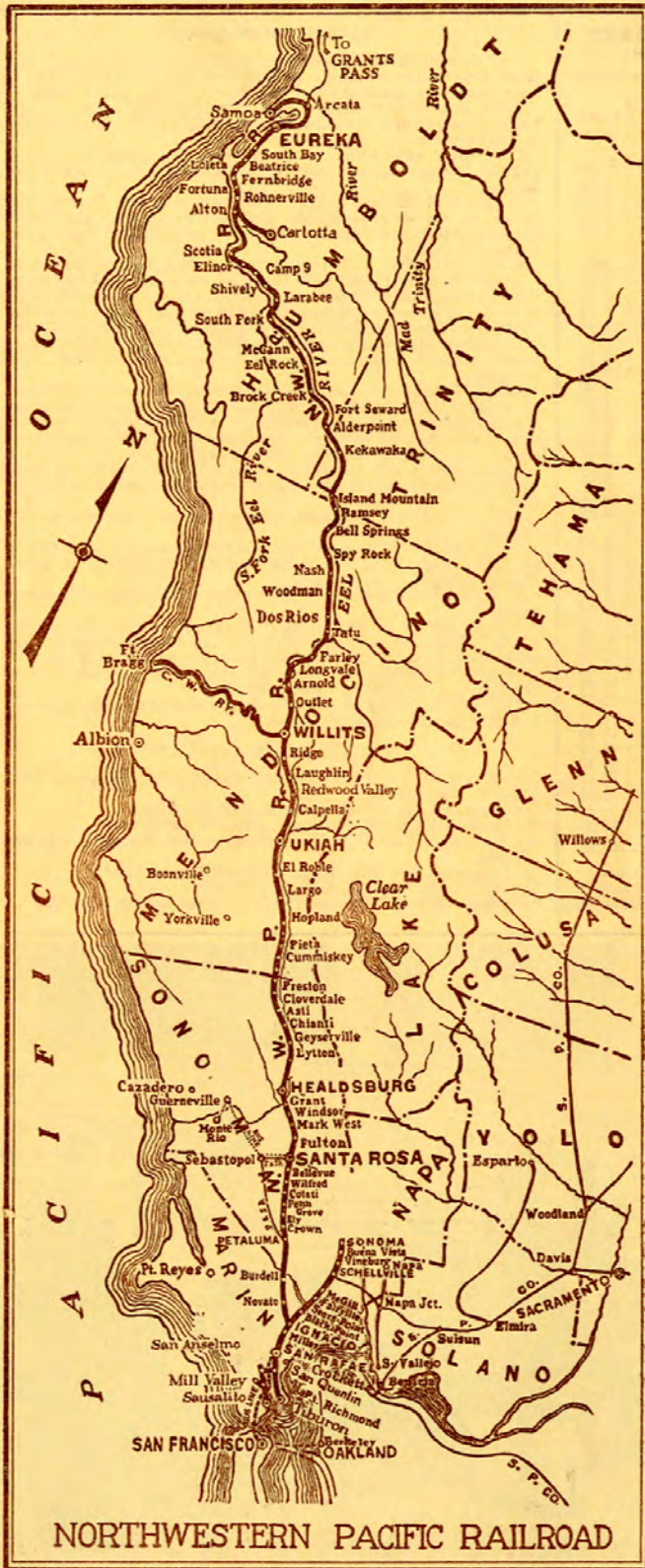

TIME. From 12:01 midnight to 12:00 noon (A.M. time) is shown in light faced figures, time from 12:01 noon to 12:00 midnight (P.M. time) is shown in dark faced figures.

CHILDREN under 5 years of age free, when accompanied by parent or guardian; 5 years of age and under 12, one-half fare; 12 years of age or over, full fare.

LIMIT OF TICKETS. Tickets must be used within limits printed thereon. REDEMPTION OF TICKETS. Tickets redeemed under tariff regulations.

BAGGAGE MAXIMUMS. No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds in weight, or 72 inches in greatest dimension, or single shipment exceeding \$2,500.00 in value will be checked. Free allowance subject to tariff stipulations.

BAGGAGE from San Francisco will be checked at the Ferry Bldg., Foot of Market St. and baggage checked to San Francisco, will be delivered at this terminal.

RED CAP BAGGAGE. Red Cap station porters, who are salaried employees, are available at San Francisco Ferry Station to handle passengers' hand baggage at a tariff charge of 15¢ per article handled. Carriers' liability for loss or damage will not exceed \$50.00 per hand trunk, suitcase or traveling bag and contents nor more than \$100.00 for each box, bundle or package and contents unless a greater value is declared in writing at time of checking. No bag or article exceeding \$500.00 in value will be accepted for handling by Red Cap porters.

LIABILITY LIMITED. Excess value to be declared and paid for when checking.
