Information Returns for Calendar Year 1964

1. FORM W-2, WITHHOLDING STATEMENT 1964

The Internal Revenue Service requires that each employee be given a United States Treasury Department form W-2, Withholding Statement, in duplicate, at the end of each year, showing total wages for the year and the amount of income tax withheld and paid by the company to the government, and that originals (Copy A - for District Director) of these forms be filed by the company with the District Director of Internal Revenue.

The Accounting Division will prepare forms W-2 for 1964 for all salaried employees, commission agents and their assistants and individuals paid by expenditure drafts, whose compensation for express service is subject to tax withholdings, and forward such forms to agents and heads of departments for delivery to all concerned on or before January 31, 1965.

In the case of those commission agents to whom total payments during 1964 amounted to \$600.00 or more, the Accounting Division will prepare forms W-2 for that part of such compensation subject to withholding, i.e., compensation for personal services, and forms 1099 for that portion representing expenses incurred by commission agents in the operation of the office which is not subject to withholding.

Forms W-2 which are undelivered as of April 1, 1965, should be returned to interested District Disbursements Manager on that date with an explanation stating why the forms were not delivered to the employees.

2. FORM 1099, INFORMATION RETURN FOR CALENDAR YEAR 1964

The Accounting Division will prepare forms 1099 for 1964 to cover payments made by expenditure drafts to individuals who have received payments of compensation which are not subject to withholding totaling \$600.00 or more during the year. Such payments generally embrace rents, payments to independent contractors and fees paid to attorneys, physicians and members of other professions.
