PROPORTIONAL CLASS RATES, CARLOADS

On all freight, carloads (except as specifically provided for in this tariff), apply the following proportional rates between College Hill Junction, Ohio, and College Hill, Mt. Healthy and North College Hill, Ohio:

Fourth class, 8 cents per 100 pounds

Fifth class, 6 cents per 100 pounds

Sixth class, $4\frac{1}{2}$ cents per 100 pounds
