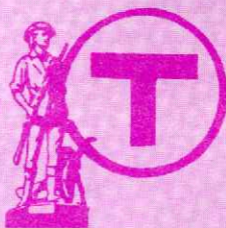

## SENIOR CITIZEN'S FARES

Are valid on any train at any time, for persons presenting Purple or Gold MBTA Senior Citizen's cards, or similar cards from the Cape Ann Transportation Authority, Merrimack Valley Regional Transit Authority, Lowell Regional Transit Authority, New Hampshire Transportation Authority, Montachusett Regional Transit Authority, Town of Franklin, Brockton Area Transit Authority, Greater Attleboro-Taunton Regional Transit Authority, or Rhode Island Department of Transportation. Also to be accepted are Driver's License, Medicare/Medicaid Card or Council on Aging card PROVIDED information on card indicates holder is at least 65 years of age.

They are valid on all other trains, including all trains on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays for persons presenting MBTA Special Needs cards, only.

## FAMILY FARES ROUND TRIP

Family round trip tickets are available at Ticket Offices and from Conductors on trains, under following conditions:

- Family group, not necessarily related, consisting of a maximum of five persons of whom no less than one nor more than two are 18 years of age or over.
- Ticket is valid for one round trip during day and date for which issued only, and is not transferable.
- Valid only on off-peak trains on weekdays (non-shaded trains) and valid on all trains Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays. Not valid to Zones A, B, RI-1 or RI-2 nor for Intermediate travel within less than three zones.
- Sold for rate indicated in "Round Trip Family Fares" column; also sold at one half this rate if one member of Family Group has a valid adult monthly pass; also issued free if two members of Family Group have valid adult monthly passes.

**STUDENT FARES**

All students, up to and including high school, are eligible for MBTA Identification Badges entitling a student to ride for ½ the regular cash fare. Fares apply only on school days until 5 PM. Identification Badges are available through the school.

## **JOINT TICKETING INFORMATION**

Twelve ride and unlimited monthly railroad passes are honored on the Trombly Motor Coach Service (TMC) buses indicated ON THIS TIMETABLE ONLY. A 50¢ cash fare shall be paid on the bus in addition to use of a valid ZONE 4 or ZONE 5 railroad ticket. RAIL TICKETS ARE NOT ACCEPTED FOR BUS PASSAGE ON SATURDAYS, SUNDAYS OR HOLIDAYS.

## **PROCEDURE FOR USING RAILROAD TICKETS ON BUSES:**

Twelve-ride tear-off tickets are surrendered to the bus driver (Calendar Monthly Passes are presented to the bus driver) and a 50¢ cash fare is paid. A cash receipt will be issued by the bus driver.

Please cooperate with the bus driver who may be required to record your ticket number.

Calendar monthly pass is good for unlimited number of commutation rides to Zones indicated during month of issue. Calendar Monthly Pass is also available for \$9.00 additional with an MBTA pass on reverse side which allows free entrance to MBTA Rapid Transit service.

## **46 RIDE INTERMEDIATE MONTHLY**

---

For those persons riding between Zones but not to or via Boston, an Intermediate Monthly Ticket, good for 46 rides in the month issued is available.
