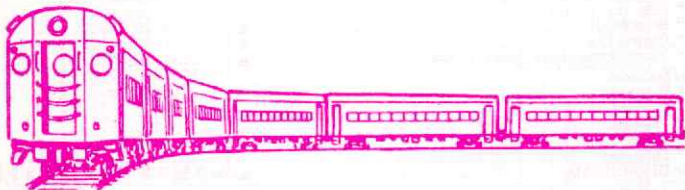

TIME—The time from 12.01 midnight to 12.00 noon is indicated by light-face type; from 12.01 noon to 12.00 midnight is indicated by dark-face type.

FARE ADJUSTMENTS—If you have any questions about the fare you are charged, ask for a receipt for amount paid and mail it with an explanation to the General Passenger Agent, Jamaica Station, Jamaica 11435.

Unused and partially used tickets may have refund value. They may be turned in at any Long Island ticket office or mailed to the General Passenger Agent.

TICKET OFFICES—At most stations, tickets can be purchased at the ticket office before train time. You'll generally save money this way and we'll be able to serve you better.

CHILDREN'S FARES—Until they reach their fifth birthday, children may ride free when accompanied by a parent or guardian. Children ages five to eleven are charged half-fare. After their twelfth birthday, children must pay full fare.

BAGGAGE—Passenger's hand baggage may be carried on trains without charge. Personal baggage can be checked subject to tariff regulations to and from stations designated as baggage stations in this timetable. Call our Telephone Information Center or your local ticket agent for details and limitations.

DOGS—Passengers may carry their small dogs and other small household pets on the train without charge. The animal must be confined in a basket or similar receptacle.

Otherwise passenger's dogs must be leashed and muzzled and will be carried in baggage or combination cars or on the rear platform of the train at a charge of \$1.00. The railroad's liability on animals will not exceed \$25.00.

Dogs and household pets will not be carried in Road "n" Rail Bus service.
