THE RAILROAD COMPANY will not be responsible for unchecked articles left in stations, cars or buses.

In addition to the flag stops shown trains will stop on flag at Broom, Union Pacific-Southern Pacific Interchange, Browning, Midway, View, Clays, Nerva, Woods, South Perry, Davis, South Brigham, North Brigham, Bristol, Harper, Callis Fort, Crystal Springs, Madsen, Pioneer, Beaton, Ukon, Summit, Farrell, Petersboro, South Mendon, North Mendon, South Wellsville, North Wellsville, Hills, West Hyrum, Anderson, Humphries, South Providence, South Logan, Greenville, South Smithfield, North Smithfield, Mack, Carson, Empey, North Cache High School, Bert, Idaline, Whitney, Beckstead and South Preston.

All regular trains will stop at Second North, Logan.

Automobile buses will stop on flag to pick up passengers, or will stop to discharge passengers upon request at any point on the highway outside of city limits. Within city limits buses will stop at points designated by bus stop signs.
