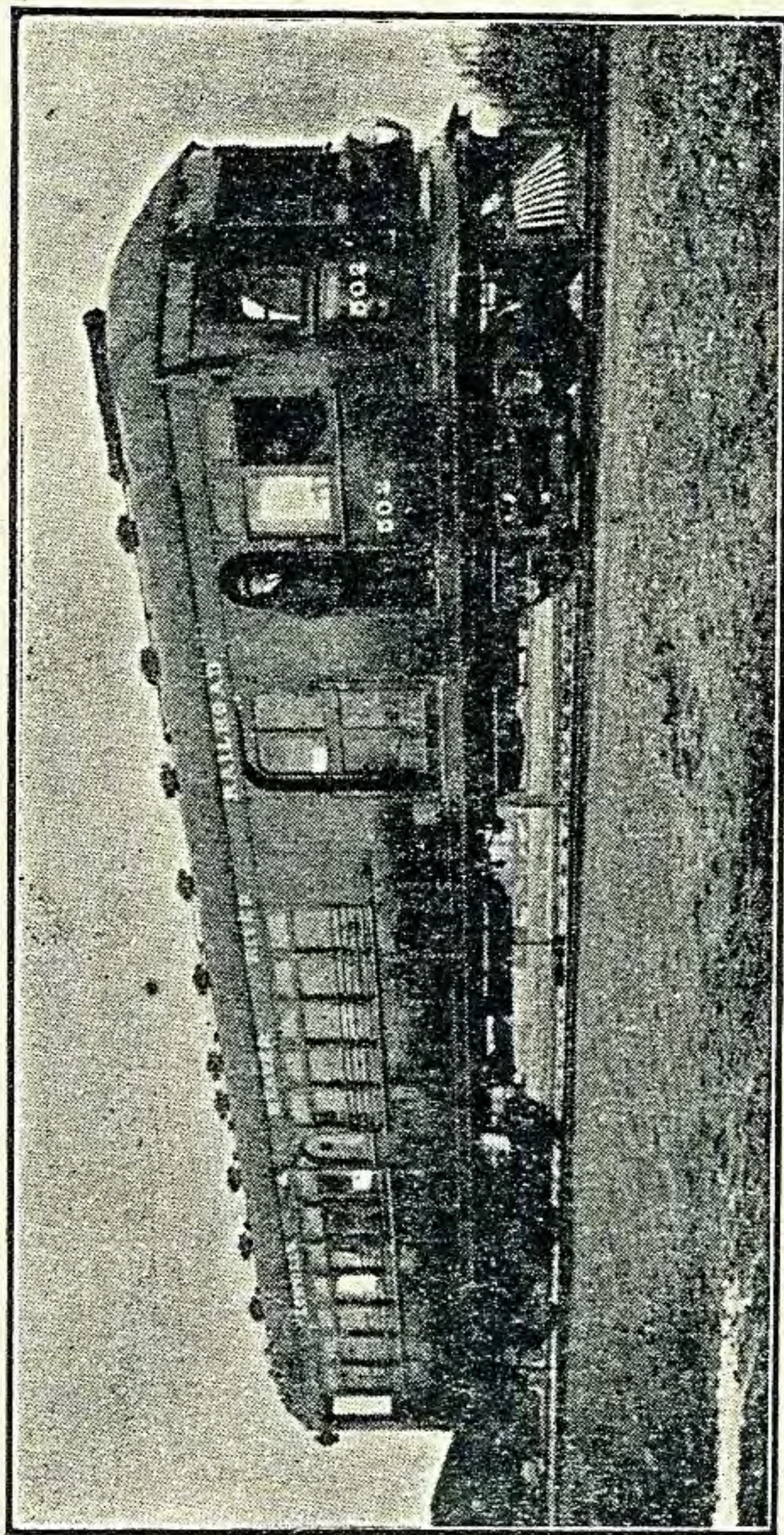

FLAG THE TRAIN—Flag the train in plenty of time. Train stops at flag stations only when flagged. Give notice to stop by standing outside of rail and swinging arm by day and light at night, horizontally across track. If no other light is available, strike a match.

Trains Nos. 2, 5, 32 and 33 will not make flag stops during months of December, January, February and March.
