SANTA FE ARRANGEMENTS AT LOS ANGELES

Passengers using train and bus coordinated service from points north to Los Angeles arriving at Los Angeles Union Passenger Terminal and holding tickets routed via Transcontinental Bus System to destination should be provided with a transfer coupon for taxicab service from Union Station to Sixth and Main Street Transcontinental Bus Terminal.

In case transfer coupon has not been issued by selling agent, passengers will request transfer from Santa Fe Depot Passenger Agent at Los Angeles Union Station for taxicab service to the Sixth and Main Street Transcontinental Bus Terminal.
